**NOTICE OF RACE**  
**Drop-Mark Divisions**

**OBJECTIVE**

Provide the women of the Tampa Bay area an opportunity to compete against each other with all female crew and socialize after the racing. Provide an opportunity for less-experienced women to compete and gain the confidence with a coach on board. Allow other participants (i.e. those of the male persuasion) to coach some of our women sailors.

In the spirit of promoting current and future inclusion in the sport of sailing, the event organizers would like to encourage Dore Drake Regatta participants to donate to the Davis Island Yacht Club/Davis Island Youth Sailing Foundation partnership initiative, the pilot "Sailor-Ship" scholarship program which promotes sailing for 9-18 year olds in Tampa, FL. The Sailor-Ship is a need based program with the goal of raising \$3000 to fund two sailors, one in Green Fleet and one high school aged. In either case, please include the word "Sailor-Ship" in the memo line. Donating is voluntary and not a requirement of the competition.

**1 RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* except that the US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.1 and 63.2 will not apply.

**2 ELIGIBILITY**

- 2.1** All keelboats, with valid WFPHRF certificates, with all-women crews are eligible, plus dinghies sailed by women. (Cruising Class has a separate Notice of Race.)
- 2.2** Divisions to race are: Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, Coach on Board (Non-Spinnaker), Dinghies
- 2.3** Boats in the Coach on Board Division may have one coach, male or female, who may not touch the helm or trim the sails except in an emergency.

**3 ENTRY**

- 3.1** Boats shall enter online at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25159> or by following the link from the DIYC Calendar page.
- 3.2** No entries will be accepted after 6:00pm on October 14<sup>th</sup>.

**4 FEES**

Dinghies: \$26.88 (\$25 plus 7.5% sales tax)  
PHRF Boats: \$48.38 (\$45 plus 7.5% sales tax)

**5 SCHEDULE**

## **6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions will be available on the RegattaNetwork event website.

## **7 THE COURSES**

Courses will be windward-leeward, as defined in the Sailing Instructions.

## **8 PENALTY SYSTEM**

**8.1** The Scoring Penalty of RRS 44.3 will apply to PHRF Divisions.

**8.2** The One Turn Penalty (RRS 31) and Two Turns Penalty of RRS 44.2 will apply to the Dinghy class.

## **9 SCORING**

**9.1** Three races are scheduled, with no throwout. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

**9.2** The Dinghy Class will be scored using the Portsmouth Rating System.

**9.3** Spinnaker, Non-spinnaker, and Coach-on-Board Divisions will be scored using WFPHRF Buoy ratings.

## **10 PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded to up to three boats in each Division, depending on entries. The winner of the Spinnaker Division will have the boat and skipper names engraved on the Dore Drake Perpetual Trophy.

## **11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or injury, disease, or illness to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
