# SAILING INSTRUCTIONS Cruising Class

In honor of the late Doris Jean Drake, beloved member of Davis Island Yacht Club, tireless promotor of women sailing, and keen female sailor.

### 1) RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* except that the US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.1 and 63.2 will not apply.

#### 2) NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

- a) Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the downstairs, west wall of the DIYC clubhouse adjacent to the Tiki Bar.
- b) The race committee will use VHF 72 for courtesy announcements.

### 3) SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagpole located west of DIYC. When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is changed to 'not less than 45 minutes' in the race signal AP.

#### 4) CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0945 the day of the race. If races are postponed ashore, changes to the sailing instructions can be posted at any time prior to the lowering of the AP flag.

# 5) RACE SCHEDULE

One pursuit race is scheduled with a base stating time of 1100. Boats will be assigned individual starting times.

#### 6) RACING AREA

The races will be sailed south of Davis Island Yacht Club on Hillsborough Bay.

### 7) THE COURSE

The course will be posted on the Notice Board prior to the competitors meeting.

# 7) MARKS and RACING AREA, which will be Hillsborough Bay from the club south to G "21" Cut C channel.

#### 8) THE START

- 8.1 The starting line will be at the mouth of the Seaplane Basin west of the DIYC clubhouse, between the two pilings located on the east and west side of the basin. The areas between the pilings and the shore on both sides are defined as obstructions, and RRS 19 applies.
- 8.2 A boat starting later than 5-minutes after her scheduled starting time will be scored DNS. This changes RRS A4 and A5.
- 8.3 The race committee may attempt to hail boats which are OCS at the assigned starting time. This is a courtesy only, and any error or omission of such a hail will not be grounds for redress.

#### 9) THE FINISH

The finishing line will be at the mouth of the Seaplane Basin west of the DIYC clubhouse, between the two pilings located on the east and west side of the basin. The areas between the pilings and the shore on both sides are defined as obstructions, and RRS 19 applies.

#### 10) PENALTY SYSTEM

The Scoring Penalty, RRS 44.3, will apply. The penalty will be 20% or a minimum of 1-place. A boat taking a penalty shall notify the race committee at the finish line.

# 11) TIME LIMIT

- 11.1 There is no race time limit.
- 11.2 Boats finishing after 1500 may take their own time and report it to the race committee.

# 12) PROTESTS

The protest time limit is 30 minutes after the last boat has finished or retired. This time will be posted.
