# **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### 1 ORGANIZING AUTHORITY & LOCATION

- 1.1 The Regatta is organized under the authority of Englewood Sailing Association (ESA).
- 1.1The event will be sailed on Lemon Bay, adjacent to Indian Mound Park, 210 Winson Ave, Englewood, FL.

### 2 RULES

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 2.2 Competitors are required to wear an appropriate self-buoyant PFD at all times while launching boats, on the floats, or on the water, except temporarily while adding or removing clothing. This changes RRS 40.

#### 3 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 12/5/2022 on The Regatta Network.

#### 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The Regatta will be open to the following classes: Optimist R/W/B and Green, ILCA 6, Pico and RS Quest.
- 4.2 Eligible competitors will under the age of 19 at the beginning of the year.
- 43 Entries will be accepted until December 9, 2022.
- 4.5 Entries will be made via The Regatta Network and linked to Englewoodsailing.org

#### 5 FEES

Required fees are as follows: \$50 for the Regatta, if paid by November 30, \$60 thereafter. This includes racing, 1 t-shirt per competitor and refreshment after racing. Water will be provided

### 6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 December 10, 2022. Check in opens at 800 hours.
- 6.2 Skippers Meeting at 1000 hours.
- 6.3 Warning Signal for the first race at 1100 hours. Additional races to follow.
- 6.4 No races will be started after 1430 hours.
- 7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS The sailing instructions will be available after 12/5/2021 on The Regatta Network
- **8 COURSES** The courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions

# 9 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 Appendix V1 will apply for all classes.
- 10.2 The protest desk will be located at the check-in table

### 11 SCORING

- 11.1 The Low Point scoring system shall be used. (Example: 1 for first place, 2 for second, etc.)
- 11.2 No scores will be excluded.
- 11.3 One race shall constitute a Regatta
- 11.4 It is the intention of the race committee to run as many races as practicable.

### **12 SUPPORT BOATS**

- 12.1 Coach boats may be enlisted as needed for additional support.
- 12.2 Coach and spectator boats shall stay clear of the race course as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.
- 12.3 Coach and Support boats shall launch at the Indian Mound Boat Ramp.

# 13 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: First through fifth for the Regatta.
