## Chumly's Last Call Regatta To Benefit Piscataqua Youth Sailing Association

## Organizing Authority Piscataqua Sailing Association Saturday, September 24, 2022

- 1. RULES: This regatta will be governed by the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY: PHRF Racing, 2022 PHRF-NE ratings will be used. 2022 PHRF Cruising non-spinnaker, and PHRF racing certificates preferred. A boat without a current certificate will be assigned a provisional handicap using the base PHRF-NE ratings with appropriate adjustment(s) as determined by the committee. J24's are welcome. If four or more J 24's participate special prizes for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 3<sup>rd</sup> will be awarded.
- 3. ENTRY: Eligible boats may enter this regatta by completing the registration form online at <u>www.sailpsa.org</u>
- 4. **FEE:** There is a one time entry fee of \$50.00 to participate in this regatta. 100% of all entry fees will go straight to PYSA funding of 2023 expansion to Traip Academy, Marshwood High, etc. <u>https://www.pysasail.org/</u>
- 5. **SAFETY:** All boats are required to meet minimum government regulation for safety equipment and comply with the Offshore Racing Council rules for category IV. The race committee reserves the right to inspect any boat for required equipment and may disqualify boats found not in compliance.
- 6. **SCHEDULE:** Skipper's Meeting: 9:30 am Saturday, September 24, 2022 @ Kittery Point Yacht Club.
- 7. FIRST RACE WARNING: 12:00 Noon.
- 8. **THE START:** There will be two starts as done during the 2022 PSA Tuesday PHRF Series. RC will use "Rolling Starts" with the second start's 5 minute warning at the first start's 0 minute, and so on. Race Committee may alter the start times and fleet start times in an effort to get more racing in, distribute yacht numbers more evenly, or to accommodate a one-design start if needed.
- 9. **COURSES:** Race Committee will endeavor to run multiple Windward / Leeward races utilizing inflatable marks. RC reserves the possibility of a longer government mark course. Actual courses for a given race will be announced by Race Committee prior to that Race's Warning Signal.
- **10.** CHANNEL 68 Yachts are required to monitor VHF Channel 68 for courses and other relevant information.
- **11. SCORING:** Scoring shall be as outlined in RRS Appendix A A4 Low Point System.
- **12. TROPHIES:** Recognition of winning boats will be online at sailpsa.org. Brag Flags may be given at a later date. Division winners are immortalized on the Chumly's Last Call Perpetual Trophy held at Great Bay May Marine!
