**1. Rules**

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024.

**2. Eligibility and Entry**

2.1 Eligible boats may enter the regatta by registering online. The Regatta is open to any mono-hull, ballasted, self-righting sailboat of at least 20' in length with a cabin, operable engine and fuel. Boats will be broken into classes as determined by the race committee, based upon registration. One Design Classes shall consist of not less than four like boats, except a multi-class handicap fleet that may be formed at the discretion of the regatta committee. The number and makeup of the PHRF classes will be determined based upon registration. PHRF keelboats must have a PHRF rating with LMYRA. ## **6. Courses**

### **Saturday – Buoy Racing**

Course Number Course Description Rounding Dist.

“1” Start-W-Finish, 3.0mi total distance

“2” Start-W-L-W-Finish, 4.0mi total distance

“3” Start-W-L-W-Finish, 6.0mi total distance

**6.1** Finishes will be between RC Signal Vessel (RCSV) staff with an orange flag and a blue flag.

**6.2** The course number will be displayed by the RCSV before the warning signal. When time permits, RC may announce the course on VHF Channel 66. Competitors are encouraged to have a copy of the SIs on board. Starting times for various PHRF ratings are listed in a chart in the SIs. If a registered yacht does not know their starting time, they can ask the RC two minutes before the first warning signal of the day.

### **Sunday – Island Fiasco**

Sunday’s race will be a distance Island Race and will involve rounding between 1– 5 islands, depending on wind conditions. Islands may be rounded in any direction and in any order. The course will be displayed on the RCSV using the “Letter designations for islands and drop rounding marks” listed in the SI for the Sunday race. Starting procedure will be described in SI 6.2.

## **7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Sailing Instructions will be available online no later than Oct 2, 2022

## **8. SCORING**

1. The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A2, shall apply.
2. PHRF using “time on time” for each designated start.
3. One (1) race is required to constitute a series.

## **9. Prizes**

Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of boats competing in each Class.

## **10. CHANGES TO NOR**

The organizing authority retains the right to modify this NOR at any time. Please check site

Land parking will be available at Columbia Sailing Club from Friday Oct 7 – Monday Oct 10
