

Entering Ensenada

All racers are strongly encouraged to get a slip in the Coral Marina. There will be medical and immigration personnel there making the process much easier to enter the port.

Medical: When you arrive, no one is allowed to leave the boat until everyone has been cleared by the medical personnel at the dock. The marina will inform the medical personnel who will come down to your boat no matter what time you arrive to take temperatures, ask some questions, and collect your filled out medical forms which will be provided.

Clearance and Exit Fees: You will need to pay clearance and exit fees which can be done at the marina office which will open at 7:00 Saturday morning October 1. The fees total \$34.00 US.

Immigration: The Immigration Service will be up in the club house near the marina office. You will need to bring a completed FMM form, have passports of all of your crew, and will pay a visa fee of \$34.00 US. If any of your crew is planning on returning to the US on land, they will need to inform the Immigration personnel and will be handed a tourist card. If you have any crew coming down to Ensenada on land they will need a tourist card which they can get at the border.

The Mexican officials have gone out of their way to make this process much easier than it would be if you were coming down by yourself.

When you make arrangements at the Coral Marina, be sure to indicate that you are part of the Little Ensenada Race so that you will get a discounted rate on your slip.
