XVII TODOS SANTOS REGATTA NOTICE OF RACE

The “TODOS SANTOS REGATTA” is organized by Club Náutico Baja

Date and location: Todos Santos Bay, Ensenada B.C., Sunday, October 2nd, 2022
Handicaps Southern California PHRF (RLC)

REGISTRATION: During the Trophy Party of the Little Ensenada Race at Hotel Marina Coral, Saturday October 1st, 2022.

CATEGORIES: This year, we will have two categories:

CLASS 1: BIG BOATS – All monohull vessels 31’ and more plus multihull vessels

CLASS 2: SMALL BOATS – All monohull vessels smaller than 31’

ENTRY FEE: The Race Fee will be: 40 US\$ per boat. This includes 1 ticket for the after-race party. Extra tickets are 30 US\$ per person. The ticket includes dinner, beer and wine tasting! The After-Race Party starts at 18:00 at the patio of Sano’s Steak House / Humo&Sal bar and restaurant (¼ mile from Hotel Coral). All participating boats will get a special reduced rate for the slip at Marina Coral.

COURSE: Around Todos Santos Island. The start and finish line will be set approx. 1 nm west of the entrance of the Marina of Hotel Coral, approximately between **31°51.1’N, 116°41.3’W and 31°50.8’N, 116°41.2’W.**

From there the first leg will be towards the north point of Todos Santos Island (bearing about 251°), then outside the Island to the south point, from there back to the finish line (bearing about 054°). The official distance will be 16.0 nautical miles.

START:

Starting time for CLASS 1 vessels is 11:00 am, Sunday 2nd

Starting time for CLASS 2 vessels is 10:30 am, Sunday 2nd

Starting sequence will be:

Attention: 5 minutes before the start, white flag up

Preparatory: 4 min. before the start “P” and “I” flag up

One minute: 1 minute before the start flag “P” down

Start: White flag down

DURATION: The Race will close at 5:00 pm, Sunday 2nd

Protests: Time limit to present a protest will be 1 hour after the race committee has arrived ashore.

BOATS NOT FINISHING: Any boat that retires from the race must give notice to the committee boat by VHF radio Channel 69.

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing ISAF (International Sailing Federation) 2021-2024. If encountering any vessel not part of the Race the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (COLREGSs) shall apply.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: Persons and boats participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

SAFETY: Every vessel is entirely responsible for her own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race, SIs or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility. By entering the Race, the boat confirms that she is fit for those conditions and her crew is competent to sail, navigate and compete in the Race. The skipper is responsible to ensure that his boat is equipped and seaworthy so as to be able to face extremes of weather; that there is a crew sufficient in number, experience and fitness to withstand such weather; and that the safety equipment is properly maintained, stowed and in date and that the crew knows how to use it. The use of life jackets is mandatory. For any emergency during the race boats should give notice to the committee boat by VHF radio Channel 69.

TROPHIES:

Trophy (perpetual) for the first boat to finish CLASS 1.

Trophy (perpetual) for the first boat to finish CLASS 2.

Trophy (perpetual) for the fastest boat (shortest overall time to finish).
