2. RULES

- a. The regatta is governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-24 with the prescriptions of United States Sailing Association ("RRS"), this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- b. Sunfish competitors should strive to adhere to the spirit of the Sunfish Class Rules. However, Class Rules will not be enforced (e.g. no equipment inspections will be performed).
- c. One race constitutes a regatta. Six or more races will be attempted. If six or more races are completed, there will be a throw-out race.
- d. Sailing Instructions will be provided at registration.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- a. The regatta is open to all Sunfish.
 - i. It is strongly encouraged that all Sunfish sailors be [Class Association members](#) of their national class.
 - ii. However, this event is NOT a qualifying event for any Class championships.
- b. Registration and payment in advance is required and may be made using the on-line registration on Regatta Network.
 - i. All registration must be done before the competitors' briefing.

4. FEES AND PRIZES

- a. The entry fee for the regatta is \$30. Late Registration - day of race (9/10) entry fee is \$40.

- b. Payment will be accepted through Regatta Network by credit card or PayPal. Checks will be accepted on-site. No cash will be accepted on-site.
 - c. One trophy per class will be awarded for 3-4 boats, two for 5-7, three for 8 or more.
 - d. Registration includes one meal ticket. If you have additional crew, family or guests, additional meal tickets may be purchased at the time of registration for \$10.
5. VENUE
- a. All races will be held in that area of the bay north of Clear Creek Channel marker #6 and marker #8 as shown in the figure below.

7. DIRECTIONS: Interstate 45 to NASA Road One. East on NASA Road One past Clear Lake. At Hwy 146, in Seabrook, NASA Road One becomes Main Street. Follow Main Street less than one mile to its end, where it tees into Todville Road. Turn right on Todville Road. SSC is 250 feet on the left. Or just search for "Seabrook Sailing Club" on Google maps.
 - a. Please note there is ongoing major construction work at the intersection of Hwy 146, NASA Road One, and Main Street which can cause significant traffic and delays. Plan accordingly and drive safely!
8. ACCOMMODATIONS:
 - a. There are several national chain hotels and motels in nearby Seabrook, Kemah, and Clear Lake City.
