NOTICE OF RACE

1. Authority and Rules

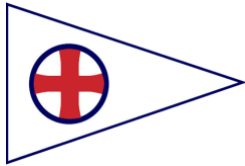
- 1.1** The regatta shall be governed by the rules as prescribed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS Version 2021-2024).
- 1.2** The Organizing Authority is Eau Gallie Yacht Club and Melbourne Yacht Club in conjunction with J-24 Fleet 87.
- 1.3** The Regatta Regulations of the International J/24 Class Association (IJCA) shall apply.

2. Sailing Instructions

- 2.1** Sailing Instructions will be available at check-in prior to the Competitors meeting and may be available on Regatta Network. Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted no later than 15 minutes after the Competitors' Meeting to be effective on Saturday, January 21, 2023, or 0800 on Sunday, January 22, 2023 to be effective on that date.
- 2.2** On-the-water changes may be made to the Sailing Instructions in accordance with Rule 89.2[c] after Flag L is displayed with one sound.

3. Communication

- 3.1** The official online notice board is located on Regatta Network.
- 3.2** The onshore unofficial noticeboard is located on the whiteboard in the outdoor youth sailing classroom on the North Side of the main clubhouse.
- 3.3** VHF channel 72 will be used to communicate during the regatta.
- 3.4** All participating boats are required to carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on international VHF channels.



3.5 A boat shall not make voice or data transmission with other competing boats or persons ashore, except in an emergency.

4. Eligibility

The regatta is open to all J/24 sailboats as defined by the IJCA that possess a valid measurement certificate. Competitors must meet all ownership and class membership requirements and complete all aspects of the registration process.

5. Entry and Fees

5.1 Entry must be made on-line through www.regattanetwork.com by 2300, Friday, January 6, 2023.

5.2 The Entry Fee shall be \$150.00.

5.3 Registration fee includes all racing, launch/haul and specified social activities.

6. Launching and Parking

6.1 Boat Launching, hauling and trailer parking is at Eau Gallie Yacht Club.

6.2 Overflow trailer parking will be at Gleason Park directly across S. Patrick Dr from Eau Gallie Yacht Club.

6.3 Boat Launching at EGYC is only Saturday, January 21, 2023 from 0800 to 1100. Boat hauling is only Sunday, January 22, 2023 from 1400 to 1600.

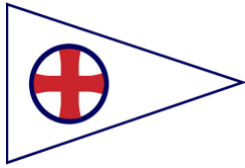

8. Inspection

All boats may be subject to random inspection or measurement by the Technical Committee at any time during the Regatta for Rules Compliance and may be required to show compliance with Part D Class Measurement and Inventory of Required and Optional Equipment forms. All participants may be subject to verification of declared crew weight per Class Rules.

10. Regatta Venue

10.1 The regatta will be hosted at:

10.2 Moorage will be available at Eau Gallie Yacht Club but not required.

11. Racing Area

11.1 The racing area will be North of the Eau Gallie Causeway on the Indian River.

12. Courses

12.1 The courses will be Windward/Leeward courses with drop marks per the Sailing Instructions.

13. Scoring

13.1 The Low Point scoring system RRS Appendix A will be modified such that a boat's worst score will be excluded after completion of six races. Seven (7) races are scheduled of which one (1) completed race shall constitute a Regatta. This modifies Rule A2.

14. Penalties

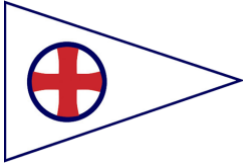
14.1 RRS Penalty Rules 44.1 as modified by the Sailing Instructions (Appendix V) shall apply when a boat may have broken one or more Rules in Part 2 or Rule 31.
