### SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

# WYC/HYC Beach Fleet Championships and Beer Can Bash Fundraiser September 24th, 2022

#### 1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Racing rules will be changed as follows:
  - 1.2.1. Rule 52 is changed to allow the use of powered winches
  - 1.2.2. Racing rule 49 does not apply to Multihulls.
  - 1.2.3.6.4 Redress: RRS 60, 63.2, 63.4 US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 60 (Participation Committee composition) are deleted.
  - 1.2.4. Rule 55 does not apply for spinnaker stopping materials only. It still applies to trash.
- 2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS: Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in the WYC on the regatta board.
- 3. CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 09:00 on the day it will take effect
- 4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE: Signals made ashore will be displayed from the WYC flagpole.
- 5. SCHEDULE OF RACING:
  - **5.1.** The first warning will be at 10:55 Saturday September 24th, 2022
  - **5.2.** The preparatory/first warning signal will be made at 1055 hours. Subsequent starts will be at five-minute intervals. Each signal will indicate a start for that scheduled sortie until the last signal. This modifies Rule 26.
  - 5.3. Number of races: There will be 2 races for A and B and 1 race for Cal 20s.

## 6. CLASS FLAGS:

- 6.1. Class A and B Pink with X
- 6.2. Cal 20 Black C20 Flag
- **7. START:** The starting line will be between two inflatable tetrahedrons.
- 8. FINISH: The finish line will be the same as the start line.
- 9. MARKS: HH- Honolulu Harbor, G1/R2- Channel Markers

#### 10. COURSES:

- **10.1.** Course #1- Start Ala Wai G1(p) HH(s) Keehi G1(p) Finish
- **10.2.** Course #2- Start– Ala Wai G1(p) HH(s) Keehi G1(p) Ala Wai G1(p) HH(s) Finish
- 11. RACING AREA: The racing area will be in the waters off the South Shore of Oahu.
- 12. PRIZES: Prizes will be presented for Classes A and B and Cal 20 at the awards ceremony
