Supplementary Sailing Instructions

These instructions augment the Standard Sailing Instructions described in Appendix S of the Racing Rules of Sailing.

1 Communications and Changes to the Sailing Instructions

- 1.1 The Official Notice Board will be on Regatta Network, event 25329.
- 1.2 The Race Committee can make on-the-water verbal changes to the Sailing Instructions. To do so, they shall display Flag L and advise, via VHF radio channel 78A, all competitors affected by the change and get their acknowledgement.

2 Schedule

- 2.1 One race is scheduled the first signal for which will be at 1055 on Saturday, Oct 1, 2022.
- 2.2 There will be an awards social and dinner at Blackbeard Sailing Club, 1215 Barkentine Drive, New Bern 28560 at 1700.

3 Classes & Class Flags

- 3.1 Boats will be divided into classes for spinnaker, non-spinnaker and cruising.
- 3.2 The Class Flag for the first starting sequence purposes will be green.

4 Courses

- 4.1 The course to be sailed and each boat's start time will be emailed to all competitors and posted to Regatta Network no later than 2100 on Friday, September 30th.
- 4.2 The length of the course will be subject to the expected conditions.

5 Marks

- 5.1 The marks of the course will be the government markers on the Neuse River.
- 5.2 When Mark "19" and/or Mark "2" are designated, boats are to round a temporary mark set on the offshore side of the government mark.

6 The Start

- 6.1 The start line will be between a staff flying an orange flag on the signal boat at location approximately at 35 02.4, Long 076 58.39
- 6.2 The race will be a pursuit race in which the highest handicap vessel(s) starts first others start later. The first boat(s) will start with a rule 26 sequence.
- 6.3 Subsequent starts, with no sound signals, will be in the order and at the times indicated on the scratch sheet emailed to each competitor and posted to Regatta Network. This changes rule 26.

7 The Finish

- 7.1 Unless shortened at a mark of the course, the finish line will be between a staff flying a blue flag on the signal boat at location Lat 35 02.4, Long 076 58.39
- 7.2 Boats are to finish in the direction from the last turning mark.

8 Scoring

- 8.1 The order of finish will be the order of placement for each class.
- 8.2 In the event of a shortened course the order of placement will be determined by order of corrected elapsed time using Time on Time calculation.
