1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta shall be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 One design classes will be subject to the rules of their respective class.
- 1.3 RRS V1 (one turn penalty for incidents outside the zone of a non-starting mark) will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The event is open to dinghies between 12 and 18 feet in length. Dinghies are defined as open centerboard, dagger board, or leeboard boats.
- 2.2 To be eligible to compete in the race, competitors must complete and sign an SCCYC Entry Form. Competitors under eighteen years of age must have their entry form signed by a parent or guardian.

3. FEES

3.1 Entry fee for each day of racing will be \$15.

4. SCHEDULE

4.2 Three races are scheduled for each event. The Race Committee (RC), may run fewer or more races.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions and Course Chart will be available online the day before the race, or sooner, and at SCCYC.
- 5.2 Notice to competitors will be posted no later than 1100 race day on the exterior wall next to the entrance to the club.

6. SCHEDULE

Racing will start at 2PM

7. VENUE

The race area will be in the main channel, inside of the Marina del Rey Breakwater, from Burton Chace Park to the Marina Breakwater. Selected races will start and finish in front of the club.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 Boats will be rated using basic Portsmouth number (D-PN) listed by US Sailing and PHRF Time on Time formula for scoring.
- 8.2 Series shall be scored as provided in RRS Appendix A for series scoring.
- 8.3 There will be no discards. All races will count.

9. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded at SCCYC, as soon as possible after racing. Snacks will be offered.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

Radios are not required but encouraged. Race Committee (RC) will monitor channel 68, and can be contacted at: 310-5000115.

11. DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
