



Turkey Trot Regatta Notice of Race

Saturday, November 19, 2022

Blackbeard Sailing Club (BSC), New Bern, NC is the Organizing Authority (OA) and venue host for the regatta.

1 RULES:

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the various Class rules, and the rules and regulations of the NC Wildlife Commission and the US Coast Guard.
- 1.2 Section V1 of RRS Appendix V-Alternative Penalties applies.
- 1.3 Sections T2, T3, & T4 of RRS Appendix T Arbitration apply. This changes Appendix T.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between the RRS and class rules, the class rules apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 2.1 The event is open to San Juan 21 (Working Sails only) and Ensigns.
- 2.2 Other one-designs may be accepted at the discretion of the OA.
- 2.3 A minimum of 3 boats must register or the event will be cancelled.
- 2.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form online at www.regattanetwork.com/event/25347 by **2000 on Wednesday, November 16, 2022**. Late entries may be accepted until 1015 on Saturday, November 19, 2022 for an additional fee.

3 FEES:

- 3.1 The entry fee for all classes is \$20.00 which may be paid online when registering on Regatta Network or by check payable to Blackbeard Sailing Club. A late fee of \$10.00 will be added to entries submitted after 2000 on Wednesday, November 16, 2022.

4 VENUE:

- 4.1 Race headquarters and social events will be at BSC.
- 4.2 Racing will be on Upper Broad Creek in the vicinity of BSC.

5 SCHEDULE:

Saturday, November 19

0945-1015: Registration and/or payment of entry fee by check only will be accepted.

1030: Competitors' meeting on the deck at BSC.

1125: First signal for first class. More races to follow as conditions permit; however, one completed race constitutes the regatta. No races will be started after **1500**

1700: Social and awards at BSC Clubhouse. Potluck after racing at BSC. A main course will be provided. Please bring a side dish or dessert to share. BYOB

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The sailing instructions will be posted no later than Friday, November 18th online at www.regattanetwork.com/event/25347 and on the courtesy notice board located on the window facing the deck at Blackbeard Sailing Club by 0800 on Saturday, November 19th.

7 COURSE(S):

The course(s) to be sailed will be defined in the sailing instructions.

8 SCORING:

8.1 Low point scoring as described in Appendix A of the RRS applies.

8.2 One completed race is required to constitute the Regatta.

8.3 If 5 or fewer races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2. If at least 6 races have been completed a boat's score will be the total of her race scores, excluding her worst score.

9 PRIZES:

Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boats in each class.

10 BERTHING:

A limited number of boats may be left in the water overnight the night before and the night following the regatta.

11 INSURANCE, SAFETY & DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

11.1 Each participating boat must be insured with an adequate valid third-party liability policy.

11.2 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**
