Notice of Race (NoR)

ABBREVIATIONS [NP] Rules that are not grounds for a protest or request for redress by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by: a) The Rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, including Appendix E, b) DragonForce 65 Restricted Class Rules,
- 1.2 [NP] All applicable governmental regulations regarding health, safety and infectious disease control shall be strictly followed by all competitors.
- 1.3 [NP] Competitors using any Chicago Yacht Club facilities, including docks, shall follow House and Ground Rules in Effect Due to Covid-19.
- 1.4 Violations of Section 1.2 and 1.3 of this Notice of Race shall not be protestable by a competitor but may be protested by the Race Committee or Organizing Authority (OA). This changes RRS 60.1.
- 1.5 A boat that may have broken rule 31 while racing does not have to take any penalty turns and violations are not protestable by competitors. Rule 31 is still in effect. This changes RRS E4.3 and 60.1. 2

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The series is open to DragonForce 65 remote-controlled sailboats only.
 - a) The use of A-Plus rigs is prohibited.
- 2.2 An eligible boat may enter by submitting the online entry form together with the appropriate fee, available at: https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25352
- 2.3 All boats must be properly registered online in order to compete.
- 2.4 Registered competitor must be the skipper of his/her boat.

3 FEES

The entry fee is \$25.00 for the series. Payable online https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25352

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Races will be held at Belmont Station on 10/8/22, 10/15/22, 10/22/22, (Sunday 10/30/22), and 11/5/21.
- 4.2 Onsite check-in will take place starting 15 minutes prior to the first start.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the warning of the first race is 1530 hours.
- 4.4 It is the intention of the Race Committee to run up ten (10) races each day.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available no later than 1700 on October 6, 2022 and will be posted online.

6 RACING AREA

The racing area will be the waters of Belmont Harbor near Chicago Yacht Club - Belmont Station.

7 COACHING

- 7.1 Chicago Yacht Club may provide on-the-water coaching during the racing. These changes rule 41.
- 7.2 A competitor shall not seek redress for failure to receive specific coaching instructions or as the result of the consequences of particular coaching instruction. This changes rule 62.1(a).

8 SCORING

- 8.1 Nine (9) races will constitute a series.
- 8.2 Once a series has been completed, each boat may exclude her worst scores, one (1) race for every Five (5) sailed for the entire series.
- 8.3 The value for a DNC (Did Not Compete) score shall be the number of boats checked in plus two (2) for that day of racing. This changes RRS A5.3
