The organizing authority is the Augusta Sailing Club at Strom Thurmond Lake at Clarks Hill.

Rules: Racing is governed by the rules defined by US Sailing: The 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing, individual class rules, ASC PHRF rules and Sailing Instructions (SI Available on-line), and as modified by the Notice of Race.

Classes: Racing is open to PHRF boats with a current Augusta Sailing Club PHRF Certificate. ILCA and 420 classes will also be included in the Hangover Regatta.

Number of Races: The Series consists of six race days. Race Committee will attempt to complete three races per race day. Completion of one race will constitute completion of the Series.

Scoring: PHRF scoring of each race will be based on corrected times. Corrected times will be calculated using the "Time-on-Time" method. Series Scoring will use the Low Point System described in Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing. Rule A5.3 will apply. The number of worst scores to be eliminated is based on the number of races completed for the Series. For every four races completed, one worst score will be eliminated.

Fees: Entry fee for the Fall Series is \$50 per boat. Registration for the series includes entry into the Hangover Regatta (1/1/23). All other registrants must register for the Hangover Regatta separately. Hangover Regatta registration is \$25 per boat.

Registration: Registration and payment will be online only. There will be no on-site registration. Boats must register before 10:00AM on Saturday of their first race. Boats not registered will not be scored.

Schedule: Race schedule is as follows: 10/22/2022, 11/5/2022, 11/19/2022, 12/3/2022, 12/17/2022, and 1/1/2023 (Hangover Regatta). The Hangover Regatta will count as the last day of Fall Series and separately as a one day regatta. A competitors meeting will be held outside the clubhouse on October 22, 2022 at 10:00 AM, as well as on

January 1, 2023 (Hangover Regatta). The starting sequence will begin at 12:00 noon on each day.

Courses: Courses will be described at the competitors meeting and posted on the committee boat.

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers for each fleet having three or more boats.
