Notice of Race (NOR)

Charm City's Ya Gotta Regatta is the Downtown Sailing Center's major fundraiser in support of our mission, and the premier showcase of our Accessible Sailing program.

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 RULES

- 1.1 This event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* with US Sailing Prescriptions.
- 1.2 For the Hansa 303, Sonar, and Freedom 20 classes, The U.S. Inland Navigation Rules (aka COLREGS) replaces RRS Part 2 .
- 1.3 Boats are provided by the DSC for J/22, Hansa 303, Sonar, and Freedom 20 classes. DSC Cruising Sailboats will be available to race in the PHRF divisions. See Sailing Instructions for details.

2 COMMUNICATION

- 2.1 The online official notice board is located at <https://downtownsailing.org/ygr2022>
- 2.2 [NP] [DP] All boats except Hansa 303 dinghies shall carry a VHF Marine Radio.

- 2.3 On the water, the race committee may communicate to competitors on VHF radio. The specific channel for each class will be announced in the Sailing Instructions and at the Skippers Meeting.
- 2.4 The Sailing Instructions will be available by 5pm September 30, 2022 at the [online official notice board](#), and at the DSC on the day of the event.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The event is open to DSC boats in the J/22, Sonar, Freedom 20, and Hansa 303 classes.
- 3.2 The PHRF Pursuit Race is open to any and all non-DSC-owned sailing boats, and to DSC cruising sailboats. PHRF boats may register for Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, or Cruising Divisions.
- 3.3 DSC J/22s are only eligible for the J/22 Class. DSC Sonars, Freedom 20s, and Hansa 303 dinghies are only eligible for the Accessible Sailing classes. DSC cruising sailboats are eligible for any PHRF division.
- 3.4 Boats may enter the event by registering online at the appropriate url:

- 3.5 The above registration pages may list additional registration requirements.
- 3.6 DSC Cruising Boats will be assigned by the Cruising Council to DSC Cruising Skippers. Cruising Skippers should email cruising@downtownsailing.org for more information.
- 3.7 J/22s will be assigned randomly, and assignments will be given out at Registration.
- 3.8 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete online registration, including any additional requirements per class, and pay all fees.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Entry fees are as follows, and include entrance into the event and use of DSC boats where appropriate:

| Class | Fee |
|--------------|----------------|
| Accessible | FREE! |
| J/22 | \$150 per boat |
| PHRF | \$200 per boat |

4.2 Meal tickets, T-shirts, and other regatta merchandise will be sold separately.

5 FUNDRAISING

5.1 All J/22 and PHRF boats are required to set up a fundraising page at <https://connect.clickandpledge.com/Organization/downtownsailing/campaign/2022YGR>. The DSC office can assist in setting up a fundraising page.

5.2 The DSC strongly suggests a fundraising goal of \$1500 for each J/22 boat, and \$3000 for each PHRF boat.

5.3 Each boat which meets the above fundraising goal will be entered into the “Charm City Champions’ Circle”, which includes meal tickets and T-shirts for all crew who participate in the regatta.

6 SCHEDULE

6.1 All activities, racing, and events will occur on October 8, 2022.

6.2 Registration and racing schedule will be as follows:

| Class | Registration | Skipper Meeting | Warning Signal - First Race |

| J/22 | 8:00 - 9:00 am | 9:00 am | 11:00 am |
| PHRF | 9:00 - 10:00 am | 10:00 am | 12:00 pm |
| Accessible | 12:30 - 1:00 pm | 1:00 pm | 2:00 pm |

- 6.3 A detailed schedule for each class may be posted on that class's registration page.
- 6.4 The PHRF Pursuit start times will be posted with the Sailing Instructions on the [event official notice board](#) and the [PHRF registration page](#). PHRF boats will start between 12:00 and 1:00pm. Specific boat start times will be based on PHRF rating.
- 6.5 No warning signal in any class will be made after 3:30 pm.
- 6.6 Racers, spectators, family, and supporters are welcome at the DSC all day. The after party will be from 3pm to 8pm at the BMI pavilion, and is open to all. Racing sailors can expect to join the party by 4pm. Please RSVP at the event webpage: <https://downtownsailing.org/event-4746870>

7 VENUE

- 7.1 The venue will be the Patapsco River, Baltimore Harbor, and Patapsco River Northwest Branch.
- 7.2 J/22 class will race in the vicinity of Fort McHenry.
- 7.3 PHRF Pursuit Race will start in the vicinity of Fort McHenry.
- 7.4 Hansa 303 Dinghies will race in the vicinity of DSC.
- 7.5 Freedom 20s and Sonars will race between the Baltimore Inner Harbor and Fort Mchenry.

8 COURSES

- 8.1 The courses to be sailed will be as follows:

| | |
|-------------------|--|
| J/22 | Windward-Leeward style courses with dropmarks |
| PHRF | Pursuit-style distance race using government marks |
| Freedom and Sonar | Short distance race using government and/or drop marks |
| Hansa 303 | Triangle style courses with drop marks |

8.2 Detailed descriptions of courses and marks to be used will be available with the Sailing instructions and at the [official notice board](#).

9 SCORING

9.1 All classes will use the Low Point System according to RRS Appendix A.

10 BERTHING

10.1 All DSC boats shall be returned to their assigned slips. Limited docking will be available for non-DSC boats on a first-come, first-served basis. Email john@downtownsailing.org by October 5th to reserve a slip.

11 PRIZES

11.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top individual fundraiser as well as the top fundraising team.

11.2 Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in each class, and to the top 3 finishers in each PHRF division.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The DSC will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Participants will be held liable for boat damage. All participants will need to sign a liability waiver before they participate.
