#### **1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY**

The Organizing Authority is Charlotte Harbor Yacht in conjunction with The VXOne Class National Association.

#### 2. RULES

- 2.1 The series will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 2.2 The series will comply with the VX ONE CLASS RULES Effective January 1, 2021
- 2.3 Sail number change(s) after the close of registration must be submitted to the PRO in writing and must be approved prior to their use.
- 2.4 Where the Notice of Race conflicts with the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing instructions shall apply.
- 2.5 Scoring See Section 9. This changes Rule A2.
- 2.6 Participants Shall be a member of their National Class Association or the International Class Association where a National Class Association does not exist.
- 2.7 To qualify for the Series Overall awards the competitor must register for the series and complete in all sailed regattas within the Series.

# 4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The series is open to all boats that meet the requirement of the VX ONE CLASS RULES Jan. 1 2021.

- 4.4 A boat is not registered until its regatta fee is paid and proof of insurance is confirmed.

# 5. REQUIRED FEES

- 5.1 Series Entry Fees: \$ 725.00 USD includes rigged storage for the Series.
- 5.2 Entry Fees for a single 2-day regatta is \$230.00 USD Midwinters \$275.00 USD- includes rigged storage 1 day before and 1 day after a single regatta.
- 5.3 Additional rigged storage for non-series competitor's is an additional \$100.00 USD per month between Dec 3, 2022 Feb 19 2023 Storage for non-Series competitors can be paid via online for each regatta. Please make storage arrangements promptly online. 6.4 Launching will be allowed 2 days prior to and 1 day following each series regatta. Additional launching can be coordinated with the Dockmaster or the General Manager.

# 7. VENUE

VXOne Winter Series events will be held at the Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club, with sailing immediately south of the Yacht Club entrance channel.

## 8. The COURSES

The courses will be windward-leeward windward or a double windward-leeward with a race duration of approximately 60 minutes.

## 9. SCORING

- 9.1 For each individual regatta, the Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 9.2 In a 10-race, 2-day regatta, one score is excluded when a 7th race is completed. This changes Rule A2.
- 9.3 in a 15-race, 3-day regatta, one score is excluded when a 13th race is completed. This changes Rule A2.
- 9.4 A boat that has entered the VXOne Winter Series, but did not start, did not finish, retired, or was disqualified shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats entered in the series.
- 9.5 The 3 regattas of 3.1 above will constitute the Winter Series. Place scores from each individual Regatta will be used in a low point scoring system (1<sup>st</sup> place = 1 point, 2<sup>nd</sup> place = 2 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> place = 3 points, etc) the boat with the lowest score will be declared the series winner.
- 9.6 When fewer than 3 regattas have been completed, a boat's Winter Series score will be the total of all her individual regatta finishing positions.

## **10. COMMUNICATION AND SUPPORT BOATS**

- 10.1 VHF radios are required.
- 10.2 Support boats are allowed and must be marked with a white flag (12"x12") on a staff. The White Flag will not be provided by the regatta. Support boats shall check-in during registration times as described in NOR 6.1

## **11. BERTHING AND HAULOUT RESTRICTIONS**

There will be no haul out restrictions. Floating docks berthing is 1<sup>st</sup> come 1<sup>st</sup> served. Rafting will be required. Support boats must arrange fixed docking with the CHYC Dock Master prior to each regatta. Maps for parking and boat storage will be provided at checkin.

## 12. PRIZES

Prizes will be given to the top three overall finishers of each regatta and the top three overall finishers at the end of the Series. In addition to the top 3 overall we will award a Top Female Helm.

## **13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to or during, or after the regatta.

## **14. INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of US\$300,000 per occurrence or the equivalent.
