



NOTICE OF RACE

The Tacoma Yacht Club presents
The 2022 Winter Vashon Race
First in the Southern Sound Series
December 3, 2022

1. Rules

- The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the Sailing Instructions of both this race and the Southern Sound Series, and USCG VTS Navigation Rules.

2. Eligibility

- This race is open to all PHRF, Cruising Class, IRC, and One Design sailboats. All PHRF participants must be current PHRF members. All participants must comply with PHRF rules and regulations.
- A Cruising Class-NFS and a Commodore Class-FS will be offered.
- One Design class will be any three boats of a singular design who would like to race as a class. Please notify the Race Chair if such a group is registering.

3. Entry

- Eligible boats may enter by completing an online entry form available through Regatta Network with an early entry fee of \$45 to be completed not later than midnight November 30, 2022.
- Entries made must be paid through the Regatta Network.
- No "same-day" registration.

4. Safety requirements

- U.S. Sailing Equipment Requirements NEARSHORE.

5. Schedule

Registration.

- Online entry form through the Regatta Network.
- Deadline: Friday December 2, 2022, not later than 12:00 noon.
- No registrations will be accepted after 12:00 noon on December 2, 2022.

Skippers Meeting.

- No skippers meeting on race day.
- Announcements will be made via the email address provided to Regatta Network as part of the registration.
- Announcements will also be made at the Friday night dinner.
- Class breaks will be made Friday night by 8:00 pm and posted on the notice board at the TYC clubhouse.

Start Sequence

- Cruising/Commodore Classes
- PHRF Classes: reverse order (slower boats first) – Class 10, 9, 8... etc
- IRC Class
- One Design classes

First Warning Signal will sound at:

- Saturday, 0925 am

6. Sailing Instructions

- Sailing Instructions will be available on the Regatta Network and the TYC Website after Nov 30, 2022 and at the Friday night banquet.
- Sailing Instructions posted for the Southern Sound Series will guide the SI's for this event as posted on the SSS Website.
- **Changes to the Sailing Instructions** will be posted on the notice board at the TYC Clubhouse before 0800 the day of the race and will be signaled by flying code flag 'L' from the TYC flagpole.

7. Course – PHRF, IRC and Cruising Classes

- Boats will start in a westerly direction across a line between the Committee Boat and a temporary mark located north of the Committee Boat leaving Vashon Island to starboard. Course will be CLOCKWISE
- Approximately ½ mile north of Vashon Island on Allen Shoal, a Committee Boat will be anchored and serving as a temporary mark. This mark must be left to starboard, and will be the East end of the finish line if conditions require a shortened course (the shortened course finish line will be the line between the mark and the southern tip of Blake Island).
- Finish in a westerly direction across the finish line between the inflatable mark located north of the TYC Clubhouse and an orange flag on the TYC deck. This mark will be illuminated in the event of an after-dark finish. Boats must provide illumination of sail numbers if finishing after dark

8. Course – One Design

- All starts will be between the committee boat and a temporary mark about ½ mile Northeast of the clubhouse. Direction of the starts will be determined by the Course selected for the day's race and may be less than complete circumnavigation of Vashon Island. Fleets not racing a circumnavigation course and without valid PHRF ratings will not be competing for overall or South Sound Series trophies. See SI's for details.

9. Penalty System

- Rule 44.1 will be changed by the SIs so that the Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

10. Disclaimer of Liability

- Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See USSA/ISAF rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

11. Overnight Moorage/Arrival

- Boats in need of moorage on Friday, December 2, 2022 should request moorage when completing registration through [Regatta Network](#).
- Moorage space is limited, and we may not be able to accommodate all requests for moorage. If you need moorage, please register early in [Regatta Network](#), and answer all questions relating to moorage. Please be prepared to raft.
- Shore power is provided as a courtesy and availability is limited.
- Any vessel disconnecting another vessel from shore power without the prior permission of the vessel's owner or the TYC Sailing Committee will be disqualified and scored a DNS. There will be no refund of the registration fee for a disqualified vessel.
- Boats arriving after 12:00 noon on Friday, December 2, 2022 need to call TYC on VHF Channel 72 prior to entering the basin.

12. Dinner, Breakfast, Shirts

- All participants and volunteers are invited to a dinner at the Tacoma Yacht Club on Friday evening December 2nd, 5:30 pm no-host Social, 6:00 pm dinner. Cost is \$20.00.
- All participants and volunteers are invited to a breakfast at the Tacoma Yacht Club on Saturday morning, December 3rd, 7:30 – 9:00. Cost is \$10.00.

- Payment for dinner and breakfast can be made through Regatta Network or by credit card or check, beginning Friday, December 2nd, 1700 at the TYC Clubhouse.

13. Prizes and Teams

- The first three boats in each PHRF, Cruising, Commodore, IRC and One Design class where there are a minimum of 5 entries will receive event trophies.

- Team registration of three or more mono-hull boats racing in a PHRF scored class representing the same yacht club will begin on December 2, 2022 at the TYC Clubhouse. Team registration should be completed by 8:00 p.m. on December 2nd and submitted to Robert Nettleton, Race Chair or a member of the Race Committee.
