NOTICE OF RACE

Turkey Day Regatta Saturday November 19, 2022

Invitation / Organizing Authority:

You are cordially invited to participate in the Turkey Day Regatta on November 19,2022. This regatta is open to all eligible boats who file the proper entry form and fee.

The organizing authority for this Regatta is the Bay Yacht Club.

Rules:

This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the US Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS) including US Sailing Prescriptions, this Notice and the regatta Sailing Instructions. In the event of conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instruction shall govern.

Eligibility and Entry/Registration:

The regatta is open to any mono-hull boat that holds a current PHRF certificate or provisional rating from South Texas PHRF. Absent such a rating, the owner/skipper may request the Principal Race Officer (PRO) issue a temporary rating applicable to this regatta and such rating decision is final unless superseded by a ST PHRF provisional rating or certificate.

Eligible boats may enter by completing the on-line regatta registration and paying the required fee.

Normal registration ends at 1900 hours CST on Friday, November 18, 2022. Late entries will be accepted until 0900 hours Saturday, November 19 and will be subject to a late entry fee of \$10.00.

Classes:

PHRF All-Sails and 150 (non-spinnaker) classes.

For the formation of a class, two (2) boats will be required. Classes may be combined or eliminated at the discretion of the Principal Race Officer depending on participation.

Entry Fee: \$30.00. (\$40.00 if registering late.)

Schedule

Registration: Until 1900 hours CST, Friday, November 18, 2022.

Racing: Saturday, November 19, 2022.

0900 hours

Skippers meeting onboard M/V Bay Star, Lawrence Street "T" head.

1030 hours

Scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race.

Signals for each succeeding race will be as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.

Time and weather permitting, three races for each class.

No warning signal will be made after 1430 hours.

1600 hours (approximately)

Awards ceremony aboard M/V Bay Star.

Sailing Instructions:

Sailing Instructions will be available at <u>Link</u> on or before November 11, 2022 and will also be available at the skippers meeting.

Venue:

Races will start and finish at a race committee signal boat anchored outside the Corpus Christi Marina breakwater. If a Race Committee boat is unavailable, the start and finish for each race will be the regular Wednesday night starting line.

Courses:

Windward-leeward for All-Sails Class. Triangles or windward-leeward for 150 Class.

Prizes:

Trophies will be awarded for the top three finishers in each class.

Competitors participate in these events entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
