ABBREVIATIONS

[NP] Rules that are not grounds for a protest or request for redress by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

- 1 RULES
- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by:
 - a) The Rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, including Appendix E,
 - b) DragonForce 65 Restricted Class Rules,
- 1.2 **[NP]** All applicable governmental regulations regarding health, safety and infectious disease control shall be strictly followed by all competitors.
- 1.3 **[NP]** Competitors using any Chicago Yacht Club facilities, including docks, shall follow <u>House and</u> <u>Ground Rules In Effect Due to Covid-19</u>.
- 1.4 A boat that may have broken rule 31 while racing does not have to take any penalty turns and violations are not protestable by competitors. Rule 31 is still in effect. *This changes RRS E4.3 and 60.1.*
- 1.5 **[DP]** Any competitor or support person who leaves the shore in a boat during this series shall wear a personal flotation device and have a cellular phone or VHF device with them. Failure to do so will result in a score of DNE for all races that day without a hearing. *This changes rule* **63.1.**

2 CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be made orally at the time of racing.
- 2.2 Any change made orally, which applies to the series will be subsequently posted online as an amendment.

3 SCHEDULE

- 3.1 Onsite check-in starts at 1330
- 3.2 In the event of too much ice in the harbor, that race day will be rescheduled.
- 3.3 The schedule is as follows:

4 RACING AREA

4.1 The racing area will in front of Chicago Yacht Club - Monroe Station.

5 **REGISTRATIONS**

- 5.1 Entry fee is \$35.00
- 5.2 All boats must have sail #s, at the very least, on the starboard side of the main-sail.2 Sail #s in accordance with the DragonForce 65 Sail Numbering Diagram are preferred. (See Appendix B)
- 5.3 A+ rigs are prohibited This changes Class Rule Section E.
- 5.4 An eligible boat may enter by submitting the online entry form together with the appropriate fee, available at: <u>https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25466</u>
- 5.5 All boats must be properly registered online to compete.
- 5.6 Registered competitor must be the skipper of his/her boat.

6 THE COURSE/MARKS

- 6.1 Courses will be W/L, 1 lap. (See Appendix A)
- 6.2 Marks will be of various shapes/colors.

7 THE START/FINISH

- 7.1 Races will be started in accordance with RRS E3.4 one minute starting sequence.
- 7.2 Start and finish line are the same.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 Nine (9) races will constitute a series.
- 8.2 Once a series has been completed, each boat may exclude her worst scores, one (1) race for every six (6) sailed, for the entire series.
- 8.3 The value for a DNC (Did Not Compete) score shall be the number of boats checked-in plus two (2) for that day of racing. This changes RRS A5.3.

9 PRIZES


Series Awards: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd for the overall series


