1. RULES:

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Participants agree to abide by the RRS and all other rules that govern this event and those of the host club. Payment of the Entry Fee acknowledges agreement and consent to this paragraph.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration form and making the required payment by 0900 March 25, 2023.
- 2.2 Entrants shall select to sail in either the Championship or Challenger Division when registering, except that the winner of the Challenger Division in the last two years must sail in the Championship Division.
- 2.3 At least three boats must be registered by March 24, 2023 for the Challenger Division to be raced.
- 2.4 The following shall be completed by the close of registration on March 25, 2023, unless otherwise specified below, before a boat's entry will be accepted:
 - 2.4.1 The registration form shall be completed in full.
 - 2.4.2 All event registration fees shall be paid in full.
 - 2.4.3 An approved Co-owner Certification Form shall be submitted, when applicable, to the host club.
 - 2.4.4 An approved Chartering and Borrowing Form shall be submitted, when applicable, to the host club.

3. REGISTRATION:

- 3.1 Registration may be done online at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25509> and on-site in the clubhouse.
- 3.2 Registration shall be completed by 0900, March 25, 2023.
- 3.3 During registration, entrants shall select the Championship or Challenger Division.
- 3.4 **Check-in at the on-site registration is required**, and Sailing Instructions, the Notice of Race (NOR) and identifying streamers for the Challenger Division will be available then.
- 3.5 All crewmembers will be required to complete a crew waiver

4. FEES:

- 4.1 The registration fee includes dinner Saturday evening for skipper and crew and refreshments every day after racing. Additional dinners may be purchased.
- 4.2 **Please see the table below for the fees and dates for early and late registration.** Please see the registration page on the website for available items.

5. SCHEDULE:

- 5.1 A maximum of five races are planned.
- 5.2 For a list of events, dates and times, see the Regatta Schedule at the end of the NOR.

6. MEASUREMENT:

- 6.1 Boats and sails must conform to the Specifications in the Class Rules.
- 6.2 All sail numbers shall match the hull number except for chartered boats, and club boats must be identified as prescribed in Class Rule, Article B-IX.
- 6.3 Each boat must carry safety equipment required by the FSSA and the US Coast Guard which includes having a bow bag and transom port.

7. VENUE:

- 7.1 The race area will be in the vicinity of the club on Canyon Lake.

8. THE COURSES:

- 8.1 The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions. At a minimum, windward-leeward courses will be included.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM:

- 9.1 RRS Appendix V, Alternative Penalties, Rules V1 and V2 will be in effect,

10. SCORING:

- 10.1 One completed race by each Division will constitute a series for that Division.
- 10.2 Each boat's score shall be the total of her race scores, and no score shall be excluded. This changes RRS A2.1.

11. PRIZES:

- 11.1 Keeper trophies will be awarded as follows:(fleet entries/trophies) 3/1, 4-5/2, 6-7/3, 8-10/4, 11+/5:

12. BERTHING/PARKING/LAUNCHING:

- 12.1 Boats may be tied to the docks at the discretion of the LCYC Property Supervisor or in designated trailer storage areas. Those arriving early or leaving late may store their boats on club grounds by making arrangements with the Property Supervisor, or at the Registration Desk.

13. SUPPORT BOATS:

- 13.1 A competitor shall not use support or spectator personnel or their equipment, including tow vessels, while away from the dock unless they have been pre-approved by the Protest or Race Committee, or made available to all competitors by an Organizing Authority.

14. RADIO COMMUNICATION:

- 14.1 The race committee may use VHF radios to communicate with competitors while racing. See Class Rules, Article S-V - Racing Restrictions, Paragraph 7 for more information regarding electronic equipment.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

15.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (see RRS 4 Decision to Race). The Organizing Authorities will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta and all events associated with it.

1. **TRAFFIC CONTROL:** Parking is not permitted on the shoulders of the road from trailer storage areas to clubhouse. The launch ramp at LCYC is a steep 19-degree grade. Safety is a paramount concern. Please review the Sitemap with parking, rigging, and launching instructions posted at WurstfestRegatta.com. **SAFETY CHAINS ARE REQUIRED TO BE IN USE WHENEVER A VEHICLE TOWING A TRAILER IS IN MOTION ANYWHERE ON LCYC PROPERTY.** Additionally, due to the steepness of our ramp please review the LCYC Trailer Safety Review and Checklist for Launching and Retrieving Boats also posted at WurstfestRegatta.com and be prepared to turn in the signed Trailer Inspection Checklist before launching.

Go 0.3 miles, turn right into LCYC grounds. The gate will be open the Thursday before each weekend of the regatta. From IH 35—go west on FM 306 for about 17 miles. Turn left on North Park Road (at blinking yellow light). Go 0.2 miles, turn right on Mt. Lookout Road. Go 0.3 miles, turn right into LCYC grounds.
