1. Organizing Authority

The organizing authority is the Sarasota Sailing Squadron, 1717 Ken Thompson Pkwy, Sarasota, FL 34236

2. Rules

This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing &the West Florida PHRF Class Rules and the One Design Class Rules.

3. Eligibility

The regatta is open to all WFPHRF boats & Multihulls and One Design Fleets. WFPHRF Fleets include: Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, Cruiser, Pocket Cruiser & Multihull. WFPHRF Fleets may be combined to constitute a class. *Non WFPHRF boats will be given a rating and compete in one class called the Fun Fleet.* One Design fleets include Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Laser, Sunfish, Flying Scot, Melges 15 & 420. Other classes with three or more boats registered will also constitute a fleet. class.

4. Registration & Fees

5. Ratings and Class Rules

Boats sailing in the PHRF fleets must have a valid WFPHRF certificate and have a copy of the certificate available. Rating certificates are available online at westfloridaphrf.org. All PHRF boats must carry applicable U.S. Coast Guard required equipment.

1255 hrs Warning Signal for first class of One Design boats

1315 hrs Warning Signal for first class of PHRF boats.

Awards as soon as possible after racing.

7. Special Event.

A Clue Hunt will be set up for all boats competing and prizes will be awarded to the boats who solve the clues.

8. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

9. The Course

The course will be in Sarasota Bay using the Compass Rose and Government marks.

- 8.1 The start for all fleets will be at marker "D".
- 8.2 The course for PHRF will be "B", "A", "G", "Is", "Cs", NP17s, NP13s.
- 8.3 The course for One Design boats will be "B". "G", "Is", "Cs", NP17s, NP13s.

10. Scoring

9.1 There will be one race.

11. Prizes

Awards will be given out. Special awards will be given for best dressed, largest crew, man overboard drill, first female driving at the finish, best "sailing" song sung at the finish, a musical instrument playing at the finish and youngest driving at the finish.
