1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. Sailing Instructions

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will consist of RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located on the club's north patio.
- 2.2 The sailing instructions will also be available online at Regatta Network after 1700 on Thursday March 16.

3. Communication

- 3.1 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 3.2 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 The regatta is open to the E- Scow, Melges 14, Windmill and Albacore classes. Additional classes may be added if a minimum of 5 boats register with approval from Chair.
- 4.2 Boats may enter the event by registering online at: <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25556>.
- 4.3 To be entered in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

4.4 For the E Scow Class, NCESA approved flotation panels shall be installed for all races during the event.

5. Fees

- 5.1 The fee will be \$175.00 per boat which includes Friday Opening Social, 1 Saturday Dinner Ticket & 1 Regatta shirt.
- 5.2 The fee will be \$175 for registrations paid in full prior to March 3, 2023. The fee will be \$200 for registrations and payments received after March 3rd and are not guaranteed the availability of Regatta shirts.
- 5.3 Additional Saturday night dinner tickets are \$25.

7. Venue

Racing will take place on Sarasota Bay.

8. Penalty System

For all classes, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9. Scoring

- 9.1 One race will constitute a series.
- 9.2 Scoring instructions for each fleet will be described in the supplemental sailing instructions.

10. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to boats placing 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each class with five or more entries. ; to those placing 1st and 2nd in classes with four entries and to the 1st place boat in classes with three entries.

11. Risk Statement

RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

12. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
