NOTICE OF RACE

February 11, 2023

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing*. Changes in sailing instructions shall be made in writing before a race by posting in proper time on the official notice board. The official Regatta Notice Board is in the portico at the main entrance to CBYC clubhouse. Class rules shall apply.

ELIGIBILITY: This regatta is open to all OD boat members of SCYA or USSA recognized yacht clubs and must be members in good standing of their Class Association.

CLASSES: Cal 20 with at least five entries.

RACE SCHEDULE: Three or more races on Saturday are planned weather and time permitting. One race completed as a minimum shall constitute the series. All races count toward the final score, no throw-out races. This changes *RRS* A2.1 The first warning signal of the day will be at 1225 hours. No race will start after 1600 hours on Saturday.

RACING AREA: The racing area will be inside the San Pedro upper breakwater, approximately 0.7 nautical mile SE of Cabrillo Marina.

SAILORS MEETING: A sailors meeting will be held on Saturday February 11 at the CBYC Dry Storage yard at 1000 hours.

COURSES & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing instructions, plus any posted supplements, will be available online at the Regatta Network website listed below by 1800 hrs. on February 10, 2023.

PROTESTS: Protests will be heard following each day of racing.

ENTRIES & FEES: Entries are online with Regatta Network at the following website: https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25586 All entries must be filed prior to 1000 hours on race day. The entry fee is as set by SCYA and posted on the registration website.

LAUNCHING: Two hoists of up to 6,000 pounds capacity and a 14' wide dinghy ramp are available at the CBYC dry storage facility located along Via Cabrillo adjacent to the main clubhouse.

TROPHIES: Trophies will be awarded at the conclusion of the regatta, based on the entries, in the CBYC dining room.

ACTIVITIES: All participants shall comply with the latest COVID-19 Social Distancing requirements of the State, County, City and CBYC. Competitors and guests are welcome to use the CYBC facilities during the event. Bar Food will be available after racing in dining room.
