## **NOTICE OF RACE**

February 18-19, 2023



**RULES:** The regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing*. Changes in sailing instructions shall be made in writing before a race by posting in proper time on the official notice board. The official Regatta Notice Board is in the portico at the main entrance to CBYC clubhouse. Class rules shall apply.

**ELIGIBILITY**: This regatta is open to all OD boat members of SCYA or USSA recognized yacht clubs and must be members in good standing of their Class Association.

CLASSES: I14 and Mercury with at least three entries in each class.

**RACE SCHEDULE**: Three or more races on Saturday and two or more races on Sunday are planned weather and time permitting. Three races completed, as a minimum, shall constitute the series. All races count toward the final score, no throw-out races. This changes *RRS* A2.1 The first warning signal of the day will be at 1225 hours. No race will start after 1500 hours on Sunday.

**RACING AREA**: The racing area will be inside the San Pedro upper breakwater, approximately 0.7 nautical mile SE of Cabrillo Marina.

**SAILORS MEETING**: A sailors meeting will be held on Saturday February 18 at the CBYC Dry Storage yard at 1000 hours.

**COURSES & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**: Sailing instructions, plus any supplements, will be available online at the Regatta Network website listed below by 1800 hrs. on February 17, 2023.

PROTESTS: Protests will be heard following each day of racing.

The entry fee is as set by SCYA and posted on the registration website.

**LAUNCHING**: Two hoists of up to 6,000 pounds capacity and a 14' wide dinghy ramp are available at the CBYC dry storage facility located along Via Cabrillo adjacent to the main clubhouse.

**TROPHIES**: Trophies will be awarded at the conclusion of the regatta, based on the entries, in the CBYC dining room.

**ACTIVITIES:** All participants shall comply with the latest COVID-19 Social Distancing requirements of the State, County, City and CBYC. Competitors and guests are welcome to use the CYBC facilities during the event. Bar Food will be available after racing in dining room.
