NOTICE OF RACE
February 25 & 26, 2023
Glorietta Bay, Coronado

Southern California Yachting Association and the Coronado Yacht Club are Co-Organizing Authorities for the 93rd Annual Midwinter Regatta.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The [Racing Rules of Sailing](#)*, except [US Sailing Prescriptions](#) to Rule 63.2 will not apply.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND COURSES

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available after 1500 on Feb. 23 at Regatta Network. They will also be available from the front desk of the Coronado Yacht Club on Regatta days (Feb 25-26).

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25591>.
- 3.2 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Martin 16, Hansa 303, and Hansa Liberty, classes.
- 4.2 All eligible boats must enter on-line no later than Feb 24th @ 1500.
- 4.3 Boats may enter the event by registering online at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25591>.
- 4.4 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.5 All boats shall have clearly visible sail numbers. Missing, improper, inconsistent, unclear, illegible, or numbers other than those used for check-in, are not permitted and may result in being scored DNF. RRS 60.2, 63.1, and A5 are modified to add that the RC may disqualify a boat infringing this instruction without a hearing.

5 FEES

- 5.1 A portion of the fees are used to help offset the costs SCYA provides to the yachting community.

6 CLASSES AND CLASS PENNANTS

- 6.1 The following classes will be offered: Martin 16, Hansa 303, and Hansa Liberty.
- 6.2 The Organizing Authority retains final authority for a boat's class placement.

7 SCHEDULE

- 7.1 Registration is available up until 1500 the day prior to the Regatta.
- 7.2 Dates of racing are Feb. 25 – 26.
- 7.3 At least 6 races are scheduled for all classes.
- 7.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is **12:00**. The warning signal for the subsequent races will be as soon as possible after the completion of the previous race.

8 VENUE

- 8.1 The racing area will be at Glorrietta Bay, Coronado.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 9.1 This will be noted in the SI's.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 4 races is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

11 AWARDS CELEBRATION

- 11.1 After race events will occur at the Coronado Yacht Club.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. The race organizers (Coronado YC & SCYA, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or another organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. As a condition of their participation in this regatta, competitors release all claims they may have against Coronado YC or SCYA and its officers, directors, members, committees and employees for damage to property, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta. Competitors shall be responsible for damage or injury caused by their breach of *The Racing Rules of Sailing* or applicable governmental rules for the avoidance of collision.

13 INSURANCE

- 13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.
