NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. The organizing authority is Mission Bay Yacht Club Racing rule(s) 4, 26, 35, 40, 44.1, 44.2, 61.2(d) and 61.3. will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY

2.1 The regatta is open to the following fleets: F-18, ILCA 7, ILCA 6, Victory, Snipe, Lido 14, MC Scow, Finn, Lightning, Thistle, Soling, Sunfish, O'Pen Skiff

3 ENTRY

3.1 Online Registration **ONLY** will be available at:

3.2 All Competitors must register online.

3.3 Fees: the registration fee shall be as follows: Boats under 10' \$27, Boats 10'-19.9' \$37, boats 20' – 29.9' \$45 and boats 30' and up \$55.

4.2 There will be no lunch breaks ashore.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on the Regatta Website on February 17th. No paper Sailing Instructions will be available

6 VENUE

6.1 There will be 2 racecourses for the regatta. 1 Bay and 1 Ocean.

6.2 The fleets sailing in the ocean will be as follows: Multi-hull, Laser Standard, Laser Radial, Lightning, Soling, Thistle, Snipe and Victory.

6.3 The fleets sailing in the bay will be as follows: MC Scow, Finn, Lido 14, Sunfish and O'Pen Skiff.

7 THE COURSES

The courses to be described in the Sailing Instructions.

8 FLEET REQUIREMENTS

All ocean fleets must have at a minimum of 5 boats to get a start. All Bay fleets must have a minimum of 3 boats to get a start.

9 SCORING

The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply. Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10 SUPPORT BOATS Support boats shall be required to monitor the appropriate Race Committee VHF channel and respond as requested.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14 PRIZES

Prizes will be given to 1 of every 3 boats in a fleet. For example, if there are 7 boats in a fleet, the top 2 will receive prizes.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16 CLUB RULES
