- 1. Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the class rules of the invited classes.
- 2. Advertising:** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 3. Venue:** Cold Spring Beach, end of Beach Street, Wickford, RI 02852. The sailing area will be on the West Passage of Narragansett Bay.
- 4. Eligibility and Entry:** The regatta is open to the **505, F-18, I-420, ILCA 7, ILCA 6, Finn, Waszp and I-Canoe** classes. All entries shall conform to the eligibility rules of the respective classes.

**7. Sailing Instructions:** The Sailing Instructions will be available at the event website after June 1, at check in or at the competitor's meeting. The 2022 Sailing Instructions will be available for reference until the 2023 Instructions are posted.

**8. Courses:** Trapezoid or Windward-Leeward courses will be used for I-420, Finn, ILCA 7 and ILCA 6 Classes. All other classes will sail Windward-Leeward courses.

**9. Scoring:** The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A of the racing rules will apply. There will be one throw-out if 4 or more races have been completed. Eight races are scheduled, of which one shall be completed to constitute a series.

**10. Disclaimer of Liability:** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Competitors will be required to complete a liability waiver at registration.

**11. Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded based upon the number of entries received through May 13<sup>rd</sup>. 10 or more entries, top three. Fewer than 10, top two. Equal prizes will be awarded to both skipper and crew in double handed classes.
