4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore shall be displayed on the official electronic notice board located on Regatta Network. See Para. 2 above.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- **5.1** Date of Racing: Saturday September 9, 2023.
- **5.2** One or more races are scheduled for both the Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker classes. One completed race will constitute a regatta.
- **5.3** Scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of the day is 1155 PM.
- **5.4** Skippers Meeting will be held at 1800 Friday, September 8 at the Oar House, 1000 S. Pace Blvd.

6. CLASS FLAGS

Spinnaker Pink

Non-Spinnaker Light Blue

7. RACING AREA

The Racing Area is the navigable waters of Pensacola Bay.

8. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be posted on the signal vessel. Non-Spinnaker class may sail government mark courses.

9. MARKS

- **9.1** The starting marks will be an Orange Tetrahedron and an Orange Flag on the signal vessel.
- **9.2** The finishing marks will be a Blue Flag on the signal vessel and the course side of a red ball marker.
- **9.3** Mark A (windward) and Mark C (leeward) will be orange tetrahedrons. Replacement marks will be yellow tetrahedrons.

11. THE START

11.1 The starting line will be between the Orange Flag and the course-side of the Orange Tetrahedron.

First start: Spinnaker

Second start: Non-Spinnaker

11.2 A boat failing to check in properly will be so notified of its failure by the RC and will be scored a penalty of 20% without a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5. 13. THE FINISH The finishing line will be between a blue flag on the signal vessel and the course-side of the red ball.

13. THE FINISH

The finishing line will be between a blue flag on the signal vessel and the course side of the red ball.

15. TIME LIMITS (Spinnaker Division only)

15.1 Time limits are as follows:

Mark A 45 minutes Time limit for the first boat to pass Mark A.

Race 2.5 hours Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish. Finishing Window 45 minutes Time limit for boats to finish after the first boat finishes.

- **15.2** If no boat has passed Mark A within the Mark A time limit, the race shall be abandoned. Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).
- **15.3** If no boat has sailed the course and finished within the race time limit, the race shall be abandoned. Failure to meet the time limit will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).
- **15.4** Boats failing to finish within the finishing window shall be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4, and A5.
