# **Supplemental Sailing Instructions 60<sup>th</sup> Annual Navy Cup 2023**

#### 2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

## 4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

4.1 Signals made ashore shall be displayed on the official electronic notice board located on Regatta Network. See Para. 2 above.

#### 5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- **5.1** Date of PHRF Racing: Saturday June 10, 2023.
- **5.2** Two or more PHRF races are scheduled. One completed race will constitute a regatta.
- **5.3** Scheduled time of PHRF First Warning Signal is 1225.
- **5.4** Date of One-Design Racing: Sunday June 11, 2023
- **5.5** Three One-Design races are scheduled for each class (Sunfish, Laser and Hobie Get-Aways). One completed race will constitute a regatta.
- **5.6** Scheduled time of One-Design First Warning Signal is 1145.

### 6. CLASS FLAGS

**PHRF** Classes:

Spinnaker Pink

Non-Spinnaker Light Blue

### **One-Design** Classes:

Sunfish Pink

Laser Light Blue Hobie Get-Aways Purple

### 7. Racing Area

- 7.1 PHRF racing area will be the navigable waters of Pensacola Bay.
- 7.2 One-Design racing will be on the navigable waters of Bayou Grande.

## **8. THE COURSES**

The PHRF courses to be sailed will be posted on the signal vessel. Non-Spinnaker classes may sail government mark courses. The One-Design course on Bayou Grande will be sailed by all three classes.

## 9. MARKS

- **9.1** The starting marks will be an Orange Tetrahedron and an Orange Flag on the signal vessel.
- 9.2 The finishing marks will be a Blue Flag on the signal vessel and the course side of a red ball marker.
- **9.3** Mark A (windward) and Mark C (leeward) will be orange tetrahedrons. Replacement marks will be yellow tetrahedrons.

### 11. THE START

**11.1** The PHRF starting line will be between the Orange Flag and the course-side of the Orange Tetrahedron.

First start: Spinnaker Second start: Non-Spinnaker

- **11.2** A boat failing to check in properly will be so notified of its failure by the RC and will be scored a penalty of 20% without a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5.
- **11.3** The starting line for One-Design races will be between the Orange Flag and the course-side of the Orange Tetrahedron.

First start: Sunfish Second start: Laser

Third start: Hobie Get-Aways

### 13. THE FINISH

The finishing line will be between a blue flag on the signal vessel and the course-side of the red ball.

# **15. TIME LIMITS** (Spinnaker Division only)

**15.1** Time limits are as follows:

Mark A 45 minutes Time limit for the first boat to pass Mark A.

Race 2.5 hours Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish. Finishing Window 45 minutes Time limit for boats to finish after the first boat finishes.

- **15.2** If no boat has passed Mark A within the Mark A time limit, the race shall be abandoned. Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).
- **15.3** If no boat has sailed the course and finished within the race time limit, the race shall be abandoned. Failure to meet the time limit will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).
- **15.4** Boats failing to finish within the finishing window shall be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4, and A5.
