

NOTICE OF RACE

DANA WEST YACHT CLUB

CREW2 - DOUBLE-HANDED SERIES

March 18, 2023 | June 24, 2023 | July 15, 2023



ORGANIZING AUTHORITY AND RACE MANAGEMENT

The Organizing Authority (OA) for this series is the Dana West Yacht Club (DWYC.) The Dana West Yacht Club Race Committee (RC) will manage this series and shall appoint a Protest Committee.

1 **RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be sailed on the Pacific Ocean in the vicinity of Dana West Yacht Club and governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the US national authority will apply.
- 1.3 Rule(s) 44.1 and 44.2 are changed. The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.4 The crew is limited to two individuals.
- 1.5 Spinnakers, gennakers, bloopers, double headsail or other free-flying headsails are not allowed. Mizzen staysails may not be used.

2 **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND COURSES**

- 2.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on the Regatta Network website <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25644> on or before March 18, 2023.
- 2.2 DWYC will host a Skippers' meeting at 0900 on the first race day.

3 **COMMUNICATION**

- 3.1 The online official notice board is DWYC's Race Bulletin Board located on the ocean side of the fireplace and <https://www.regattnetwork.com/event/25644>
- 3.2 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 3.3 A boat shall neither make radio or data transmissions while racing nor receive radio or data communications not available to all boats after the first warning signal sounds. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

4 **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all yachts whose owners or chartering skippers are members of yacht clubs affiliated with SCYA or a club affiliated with US Sailing.
- 4.2 Eligible boats shall enter by completing and submitting the DWYC entry form on Regatta Network www.regattanetwork.com [event/25644](http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25644) under Dana West Yacht Club (DWYC). A copy of the PHRF rating certificate may be submitted with the entry. If no PHRF rating certificate is supplied, a rating will be assigned at the sole discretion of the DWYC Race Committee.
- 4.3 Entries will be accepted until 0900 Saturday, March 18, 2023.

5 **FEES**

- 5.1 There is a \$35.00 entry fee, for the race 3-day series; or \$15.00 per day of racing. A \$5.00 late fee is applied to registrations processed on or after the Wednesday prior to race day. Registrations are not accepted if processed less than 24-hours prior to the 11:55 race warning, and any fees collected will be reimbursed. Fees are forfeited if a cancellation is made less than 72 hours prior to race day. No fees are reimbursed for the series after the first race has started.

6 **SCHEDULE**

- 6.1 Races in this series will be held on :
 - Saturday, March 18, 2023
 - Saturday, June 24, 2023
 - Saturday, July 15, 2023
- 6.2 The number of races scheduled for each day depends upon the weather, but the goal will be two races.
- 6.3 The first warning signal will be made at 11:55 on race day.
- 6.4 The class assignments and ratings will be announced at the Skippers' Meeting on March 18, 2023 at 0900 hours at the Dana West Yacht Club. Any subsequent changes will be available on the Regatta Network page and posted by the DWYC entrance window and race board on the ocean side of the fireplace.

7. **THE RACE COURSES**

- 7.1 The courses to be sailed will be selected from the Dana Point Race Chart v.08.0, (available at <http://dwyc.org/dwyc-race-chart/>) and the selected course number will be displayed from the committee boat on a white board.

8. **SCORING**

- 8.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply with modifications detailed in the Sailing Instructions. Handicaps will include the non-spinnaker offset.

9 BERTHING

- 9.1 Competitors requiring an overnight berth in Dana Point Harbor may call the DWYC Dock Master for assistance. Contact Ray Bell at (949) 488-3011 or dockmaster@dwyc.org.

10 INSURANCE

- 10.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.

11 PRIZES

- 11.1 Overall Daily Trophies will be awarded at the end of day, and Overall Series Trophies will be after the last race on July 15, 2023 at or about 1600 at the DWYC Clubhouse.
