## NOTICE OF RACE

# Waikiki Opening Day Beer Can Bash February 18, 2023

#### 1. RULES:

- 1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 2. The Racing rules will be changed as follows:
  - 1. Rule 52 is changed to allow the use of powered winches
  - 2. Rule 47 is changed to allow the use of banding for safety purposes
- 3. Rule 63.2 and 63.4 do not apply.
- 2. **ADVERTISING:** Advertising will not be restricted.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- The regatta is open to all boats of the classes: X (PHRF<=31), A (PHRF>31), B(PHRF>105), C (Cruising Class), Cal 20, and multihull, with skippers who are members of HYRA member clubs.
- 2. Yachts will be scored in a class if there are 3 or more entries
- 3. Eligible boats may enter by registering on Regatta Network by the skippers meeting: https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25649
- 4. **FEES:** The entry fees for X, A, B, and Cruising will be \$25.00 and \$10.00 for Cal 20s

### 5. SCHEDULE

- 1. Regatta Network registration closes at the time of the skipper's meeting
- 2. Skippers' Meeting: 1145 Saturday, February 18th 2023
- 3. First Warning: 1325 Saturday, February 18th 2023
  - 1. Racing will be postponed until all entered boats have received the "Blessing of the Fleet" from the Opening Day VIP Boat and arrived in the starting area.
- 4. Number of Races: All fleets will have one race
- 6. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting and on Regatta Network by February 1, 2023
- 7. VENUE: The Course Area will be off the south shore of Oahu
- 8. **COURSES:** Courses will be displayed by the Race Committee at or prior to the warning of the race as described in the Sailing Instructions
- 9. SCORING: The scoring system is as follows:
  - 1. X, A, B, and Cruising will use PHRF Handicap rating systems as endorsed by HYRA
  - 2. Cal 20s will use The Low Point Scoring System
- 10. PRIZES: Prizes will be presented at the awards ceremony
