A Friendly Reminder For Pet Owners

We love our pets here at FWBC, but we'd like to remind all owners to keep pets leashed and outside the TABC lines of the Club.

Can I bring my pet to the Club?

Absolutely, but there are restrictions. Pets must be under control, on leash, and kept outside of the *no-go zone*. Pet friendly areas include the parking lot, the lawn surrounding the flagpole, and the far side of the lawn past the pool.

In addition, you're welcome to walk your pet through the no-go zone if you are heading to your boat for a day out on the water.



Are there off-leash areas at FWBC?

No - pets must be on leash at all times while on FWBC grounds.

What is the official rule concerning pets at FWBC?

For common property at FWBC, pets are only allowed outside the TABC line (the Texas Alcoholic Commission delineated boundary where alcohol not bought at the Club House can be consumed). Absolutely no pets are allowed in areas beyond that line, including but not limited to the Club House, patio and pool grounds.

Club members who are owners of pets are fully responsible for their pet's actions (Club members are responsible to assure their guests comply with this rule).

Pets shall be leashed at all times when outdoors and must not bother, threaten, endanger, harm, or be a nuisance to persons or other animals on Club property, including cabana neighbors. Pet waste must be cleaned up immediately and properly disposed (there are several grassy areas outside the TABC line, including by the flagpole).
