SAILING INSTRUCTIONS Amendment #2

The courses and distances for the 2023 Griffith Series have been changed as follows: This replaces all course description in the NOR and SI.

The new course chart is #2023-2 (3/22/2023).

Race Courses. The revised 2023 George Griffith Series Course Chart defines four courses.

1.1 Start east of pier 400 in Los Angeles Harbor, exit the harbor at Angel’s Gate, round the Point Fermin buoy to port, round Queen’s Gate to port, finish back at the start/finish line east of pier 400.

1.2 Start east of pier 400 in Los Angeles Harbor, round the west end of the middle breakwater (50) to port, re-enter the harbor at Queen’s Gate, round Island Chaffee (8) to port, finish back at the start/finish line east of pier 400.

1.3 Start east of pier 400 in Los Angeles Harbor, round the west end of the middle breakwater (50) to port, round Queen’s Gate to port, finish back at the start/finish line east of pier 400.

1.4 Start east of pier 400 in Los Angeles Harbor, exit the harbor at Angel’s Gate, round the Point Fermin buoy to port, re-enter the harbor at Queen’s Gate, round Island Chaffee to port, finish back at the start/finish line east of pier 400.

Before the attention signal the PRO will hail the fleet on UHF Channel 71 to announce the course and it will be displayed on the board. If it is necessary to postpone the start, a revised pursuit start will be scheduled in increments of 30 minutes, (i.e., first start 1330, or first start 1400).
