1 RULES

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2 CLASSES & ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Classes to be sailed: VX One Design and Viper 640. All classes will start at the same time to be scored overall and in their sub-class.
- 2.2 All entrants must complete the registration on Regatta Network:
- 2.3 The top GYA Team will qualify for the US Sailing's Adult Championship, The Mallory Trophy.

3 ENTRIES & FEES

3.1 Fees: \$65. All valid entries will be accepted by completing registration and making payment on Regatta Network by 1030 HRS on Saturday, August 12th, 2023.

4 SAFETY

4.1 All boats shall comply with USCG safety equipment regulations and class rules.

- 5.3.2 1600 No race will Start after this Time
- 5.3.3 Trophy Ceremony following all races

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Sailing Instructions will be available on Regatta Network.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 Scoring will be the low point system of Appendix A. A competitor will be allowed to discard one (1) race, if seven (7) or more races are scored.
- 7.2 Sub-classes will be scored using the boats their sub-class. This changes RRS 8.2.
- 7.3 The top GYA Team will qualify for the US Sailing's Adult Championship, The Mallory Trophy.

8 TROPHIES

8.1 Trophies will be awarded to the top three (3) in each sub class and the overall winner.
