ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Regardless of your brand of beach cat, each skipper must be a current member of the HCANA (Hobie Class Association of North America) in order for the fleet to meet the event insurance requirements.

All skippers are required to carry proof of personal liability insurance of \$100,000. Most homeowners and renter policies will cover personal liability, check with your agent to confirm. Download or print out a current declarations page to show our registration volunteers when you check-in at the regatta HQ.

YES YOU NEED A PASSPORT!

Make sure you and your traveling companions have valid IDs. To reenter the United States, you will need to present a valid passport or passport card. All children under 16 (even infants) are required to have a passport. Be sure to plan ahead. New passports can be obtained from your US Post office or online: www.usa.gov/passport

Puerto Peñasco is 62 Miles across the U.S./Mexican Border, and is declared a "Free Zone" a travel Visa is not required.

PAPERWORK FOR YOUR BOAT!

If you register your boat in your home state, bring the registration paperwork! If your Hobie is not registered within your state, be sure to bring a Bill of Sale for your Hobie. If you don't have one make one, include your hull number and make it look official! Same for your trailer - Bring Your Current Trailer Registration! In past regattas, boats have been denied entry at the border for lack of proper paperwork showing ownership.

BRING YOUR VHF RADIO

We encourage you to carry a personal VHF radio to monitor race committee communications and to declare an emergency or ask for assistance from the race committee.

Race Committee is on channel 68.

MEXICAN AUTO INSURANCE

If you are traveling into Mexico, you are required by law to have Mexican Automobile Insurance. Your US auto insurance liability policy, even if it bears a limited Mexican endorsement, is not recognized by Mexican authorities. **A separate Mexican Liability policy is required by Mexican Law.** Inexpensive Insurance can be purchased for the weekend at gas stations and insurance agents in **Gila Bend, Ajo, Why, or Lukeville.**

Having an auto accident in Mexico can be a felony, rather than a misdemeanor. Whenever you are involved in an automobile accident in Mexico, you must immediately be able to prove financial responsibility in either of two ways: 1) Immediate Cash to cover all damages OR 2) An approved Mexican insurance policy. All Citizens driving in Mexico are subject to the laws of Mexico.

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED INTO MEXICO

U.S. citizens are warned against taking any type of firearm or ammunition into Mexico without prior written authorization from the Mexican authorities. Entering Mexico with a firearm, some kinds of knives or even a single round of ammunition is illegal, even if the weapon or ammunition is taken into Mexico unintentionally. The Mexican government strictly enforces its laws restricting the entry of firearms and ammunition. Violations have resulted in arrests, convictions, and long prison sentences for U.S. citizens

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED BACK INTO USA

All travelers entering the United States are required to DECLARE any meats, fruits, vegetables, plants, seeds, or animals. Most fruits, vegetables, and plants may not be brought into the United States. Fresh, dried, or canned meats and meat byproducts are prohibited entry into the US.
