- **Arrival at Gibson Island**

If you plan to arrive prior to Friday, June 23rd, please call the Harbor Master's Office (410-255-7632) to coordinate boat storage. Boat storage is available until July 1. Please label your trailer with your name and cell phone number.

- **Gibson Island Boat Works**

The Boat Works is a full service yacht yard. If you discover some last minute repairs are needed, please drop in or better yet call 410-255-8777 to give them a heads up.

- **Friday Night Party - 1800**

Bob and Jane Dunigan are the party hosts. The address is 1732 Banbury Road. You can walk about ½ mile from the Yacht Yard, but may prefer to drive. Park along the side of Banbury Road and walk up the driveway.

- **Saturday Night Dinner- 1800**

The Saturday night dinner will be held in the Gibson Island Club House. The fees for skipper and crew are included with your entry. Help us plan by paying the \$65.00 fee for each additional guest on the event web site no later than Tuesday, June 20th.
