Start:	Between orange flag on the Signal Boat and Annapolis Area Chart mark "X" (R "2"), or alternative mark if the Signal Boat displays the "L" flag and moves to another location.

Radio:	Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee. Competitors retiring are requested to notify the Race Committee by hail or VHF.

	Sailing Instructions shall be posted on Regatta Network on or about May 18, 2023, with amendments as necessary through May 26, 2023.				
Course:	All Classes will sail the same course - Annapolis Area Chart - round mark "Q" (R "84A") to port, mark "F" (R "2A") to port and mark "N" (R "4") to starboard (20.2 nautical miles).				
Finish:	All classes to finish between Region 3 Miles River and Eastern Bay Area Mark "H" (RN"8") and the orange flag on the Signal Boat.				
Time Limit:	8 hours from start of Class – Boats finishing after 1500 should take their own finish time and note the boats before and after.

Radio Communication:

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.

Awards: 1st place trophy for 3 boats, 2nd/6, 3rd/9 & 4th/12 in each class. Awards will be presented at the post-race party as early as possible – an announcement will be made ½ hour prior to presentations.

Rhine Trophy will be awarded to the MRYC skipper with the best corrected finish using a rating system described in the Sailing Instructions.

Beneteau America will also award prizes to the top three Beneteaus in the Cruising Class and the top three Beneteaus in the Handicap Classes.

Other: Additional information, including scratch sheets, shall be posted on Regatta Network <u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25890</u> when available.

Social: Skippers and their guests are invited to rendezvous at MRYC after the race. Live entertainment, food and drink will be featured on Saturday after the race.

Docking: A limited number of slips are available. Please inquire at www.dockwa.com.

<u>Rafting</u>: The rafting off the pier T-heads is free. There is also free rafting in the Club's West basin for boats drawing four feet or less. Please follow rafting instructions from the club patrol boat.

<u>Tender Service</u>: For boats wishing to anchor in or near Long Haul Creek, tender service will be available on Saturday from race finish to midnight. On Sunday, tender service will begin at 0800 and end at 1000.

<u>Food/Drink</u>: A la carte food options will be available on the lawn or inside the Club starting after the racing concludes. Tables for dining will be available on the lawn and inside the Club. Ice will be available for racers from arrival to departure.

<u>Breakfast</u> will be served Sunday 28th May 2023 – Complimentary Danish & Coffee from 0800 -0900. Breakfast sandwiches from 0830 - 0900. Full breakfast available after 0900.
