Sailing Instructions Saturday, March 11th, 2023 Hawaii Yacht Club and Waikiki Yacht Club

1. RULES

- 1.1. The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
 - 1.1.1. RSS 52 is modified to allow the use of autopilot for doubled and single-handed racers only.
 - 1.1.2. RSS 52 is modified to allow the use of powered winches.
 - 1.1.3. RSS 47 is modified to allow the use of banding for safety purposes.
 - 1.1.4. RSS 63.2 and 63.4 do not apply.


2. COMMUNICATION WITH COMPETITORS

4. COURSE

- 4.1. Course 1
 - 4.1.1. Start Ala Wai R2(P) DH(P) Keehi L1(S) Ala Wai G1(P) Finish.
- 4.2. Course 2
 - 4.2.1. Start Ala Wai R2(P) DH(P) H Buoy(S) Ala Wai G1(P) Finish.
- 4.3. Course 3
 - 4.3.1. Start Ala Wai G1(S) H Buoy(S) Ala Wai G1(P) Finish.
- 4.4.Course 4
 - 4.4.1. Start Ala Wai G1(P) Ala Wai R2(P) Finish.

5. THE START

- 5.1. Your staggered start time will be given to you at the skippers meeting. The HYC digital clock will be used as the official time.
- 5.2. The starting line will be between the flagpole at HYC and a buoy in the turning basin.

6. THE FINISH

- 6.1. The finish line will be between the flagpole at HYC and a buoy in the turning basin.
- 6.2. All boats shall record their own finish time according to the HYC digital clock and report it to the Race Committee upon request.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. Scoring will follow the Red Cross rules of racing.
 - 7.1.1. For each \$50 donating under your boats name, 1 minute will be subtracted from your finish time.





8. SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 8.1.VHF Channel 68 is reserved for essential communications, otherwise yachts shall monitor VHF Channel 16.
- 8.2. Upon withdrawing from the race, yachts shall inform the race committee via VHF Channel 68, by voice hail, or by calling Travis Scott. (808) 383-3619

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

9.1.Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the race.

10. INSURANCE

10.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$500,000 per event or the equivalent.
