New mark (change mark)	Yellow Tetrahedron


### 11 THE FINISH

- 11.1 The Start Finish Line is **OPEN**.
- 11.2 The race committee may display flag A (with no sound) while boats are finishing to signal that there will be no more races that day.

#### **12 TIME LIMITS**

12.1 No time limits will apply. NoR 1.3 allows the race committee to finish boats on the course.
