1 RULES

1.1 The Sailing Instructions will be the STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTIONS, RRS Appendix S and these Supplementary Sailing Instructions.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

2.1 The “Race Office” will be a table set up in the OSYC Dining Room outside the lounge. The official notice board will be adjacent to that table.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

4.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed from a pole on the lawn between the clubhouse and the beach west of the OSYC Clubhouse.

4.2 The race committee will make courtesy broadcasts on VHF channel **68**.

8.1 The marks are listed and described as:

Start & Finish mark	Orange Cylinder
'A' mark (weather mark)	Green Tetrahedron
'A1' mark (weather offset mark)	Orange Ball
Gate marks (port & stbd leeward marks)	Orange Tetrahedrons
New mark (change mark)	Yellow Tetrahedron

11 THE FINISH

11.1 The Start – Finish Line is **OPEN**.

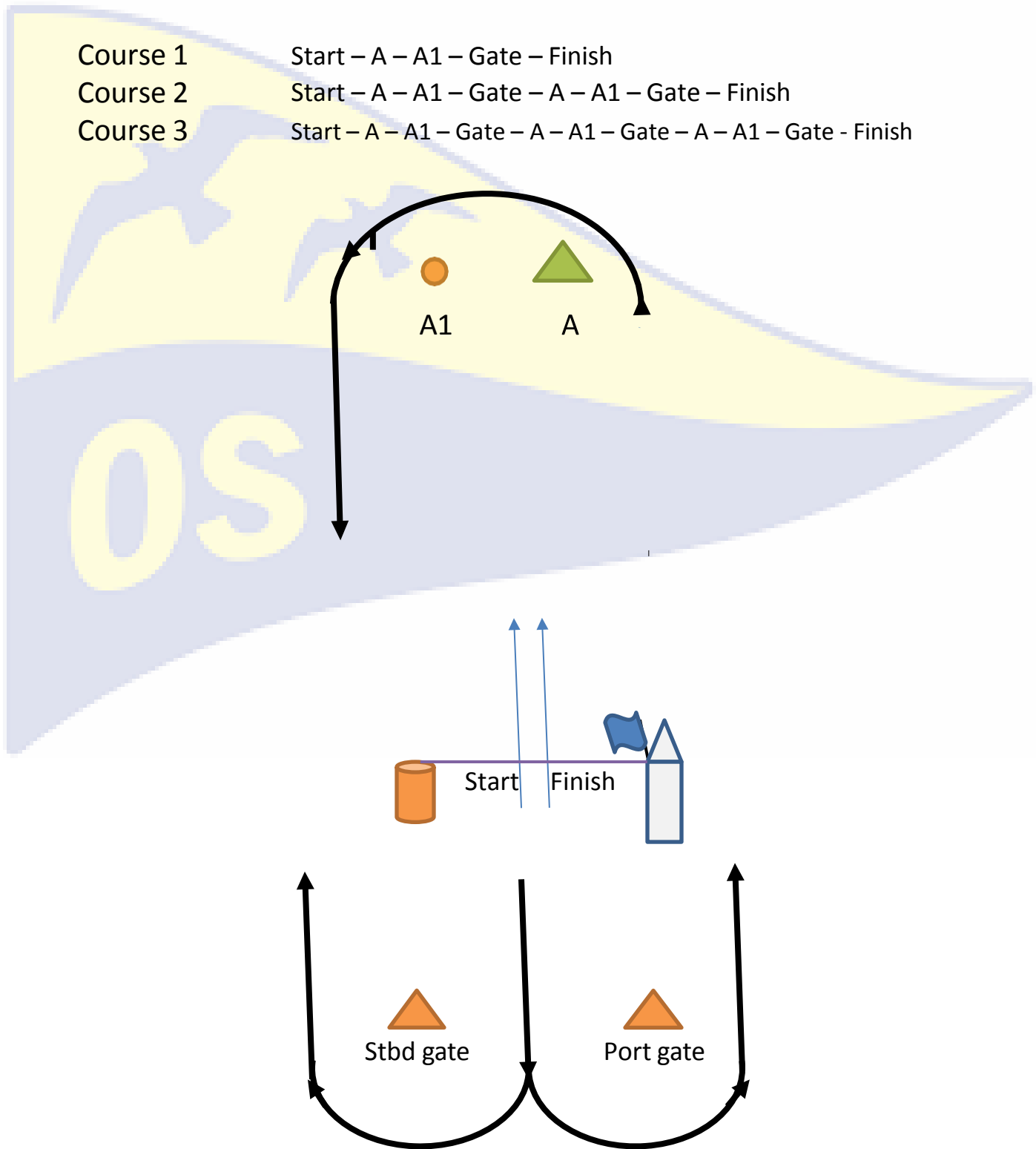
11.2 The race committee may display flag A (with no sound) while boats are finishing to signal that there will be no more races that day.

12 TIME LIMITS

12.1 No time limits will apply. NoR 1.3 allows the race committee to finish boats on the course.

- Course 3 Start – A – A1 – Gate – A – A1 – Gate – A – A1 – Gate - Finish



Either leeward gate mark may be rounded. Starboard gate mark shall be left to starboard and Port gate mark shall be left to port.
