NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2021-2024* and the Y-FLYER class by-laws and as modified by the sailing instructions.
- 1.2 Appendix V will be in effect.
- 1.3 The USS prescriptions rules 63.2 is deleted
- 1.4 [NP] All boats shall have sail numbers.
- 1.5 The notation [NP] in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a). The notation [DP] means that the penalty may be less than disqualification.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The event is open to members of the Y-Flyer class.
- 2.2 All Skippers and Crews must be a current Active, Life, Junior, or Crewmember of the Canadian or American Y-Flyer Sailing Association. Class memberships are available at YFlyer.org or may be obtained at the regatta.
- 2.3 All Skippers and Crews in the Junior National Championship must not have reached their 19th birthday on or before June 14, 2023.
- 2.4 Competitors sailing in the Senior National Championship Regatta may register for the Senior Fleet or the Challenger Fleet. The Fleet designation may be changed at any time up until the Warning Signal of the first of the Senior National Championship series.
- 2.5 Eligible boats may enter by completing registration for the regatta ONLINE prior to the cutoff date/time of Sunday June 11th at 7pm at https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25965

3. FEES

3.1 Junior National Championship

- 3.1.1 Entry fee of \$100 per skipper. Registration includes Sunday Dinner, Monday and Tuesday continental breakfast, lunch, and dinner, as well as the Friday Banquet for each skipper and crew. Additional meals may be purchased for *each day* in the "online storefront". Water and soda will be available 24/7 in coolers at the clubhouse.
- 3.1.2 Entry fee is discounted \$5 for current US Sailing members.
- 3.1.3 Late fee of \$15 for registrations received after May 31, 2023

3.2 Senior National Championship and Challenger Fleet (as per Article 19.7, Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws)

- 3.2.1 Entry fee \$350 per skipper. Registration includes Tuesday Welcome Dinner and Wednesday, Thursday, Friday continental breakfast, lunch, and dinner for each skipper and crew. Additional meals may be purchased for *each day* in the "online storefront". Water and soda will be available 24/7 in coolers at the clubhouse.
- 3.2.2 Entry fee is discounted \$5 for current US Sailing members.
- 3.2.3 Late fee of \$25 for registrations received after May 31, 2023
- 3.2.4 There will be a \$20 discount if your crew is registered for, and raced in the Jr. Championship to compensate for the Friday Banquet included in their registration. Please contact vetbags@gmail.com to apply this discount.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Sailing instructions will be available online prior to June 12 and will be posted on the official notice board on the west side of the Club House.

6. COURSES

6.1 The courses to be sailed will be Windward-Leeward, Triangle and Olympic. Diagrams of the courses will be in the sailing instructions.

7. SCORING

7.1 The Sanctioned Race Scoring in Appendix A of the Class By-Laws shall apply.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

8.1 Rules VI and V2 of Appendix V will be explained in the Sailing Instructions.

9. SUPPORT BOATS

9.1 Support boats will be on the water to provide safety and will also carry water available to competitors.

10. AWARDS

10.1 The number of awards given will be based on the number of registrants.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. COACH AND SPECTATOR BOATS

- 12.1 [DP] Coach boats and spectator boats shall be restricted to certain areas by PRO of the respective courses.
- 12.2 [DP] All support vessels shall be equipped with a functioning engine safety cutoff switch (kill switch) which shall remain attached to the operator at all times while the engine is running.

13. VHF RADIOS

- 13.1 [DP] VHF radios are required for all RD boats, coach boats, spectator boats and other visitors on the water. Please monitor the signal boat on channel 72.
- 13.2 [DP] Except in an emergency a boat shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor receive radio communication not available to all boats. No other electronic devices are allowed.
- As a courtesy, the Race Committee may announce relevant information or to call OCS's. Failure to hear transmissions from the Race Committee, the timing or the sequence of calling of OCS's on VHF shall not be a cause for redress.
