

## GOOMBAY REGATTA Coconut Grove Sailing Club May 27 & 28, 2023

## NOTICE OF RACE

- 1. The Coconut Grove Sailing Club (CGSC) will host the annual Goombay Regatta on Biscayne Bay, May 27 & 28, 2023. PHRF boats will race on Saturday. May 27th. One Design boats will race on Sunday. May 28th.
- 2. The races will be governed by the Rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, BBYRA Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, Part I General Conditions, One Design and Cruising, Sections 2, 4.2, 5.1, 7, 8.1, 9, 10.1, 12, 13 and 14; Part II Sailing Instructions: One Design; Part III Sailing Instructions: Racing/Cruising; and Part IV Championships, Scoring and Awards, Section S2.1 and this Notice of Race. Current BBYRA Registration is not required for this regatta. No separate Sailing Instructions will be issued. The September 2022 August 2023 BBYRA General Conditions and Sailing Instructions may be downloaded from <a href="https://www.bbyra.net">www.bbyra.net</a>.
- 3. The Official Notice Board for the PHRF event is online at Regatta Network, <a href="https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25984#\_newsroom">https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25984#\_newsroom</a> and for the One Design, <a href="https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25982#">https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25982#</a> newsroom. Any changes to the Sailing Instructions for the Races on either day will be posted on the Notice Board for that day's event at Regatta Network by 1900 Hours on the previous day.
- 4. The Handicap-rated Regatta on Saturday will consist of a Pursuit Race with Designated Marks specified by BBYRA General Conditions and Sailing Instructions. All boats must monitor VHF Ch. 73.
  - The One-Design Regatta on Sunday will consist of three scheduled races, with Courses and Marks as specified by BBYRA General Conditions and Sailing Instructions, PART II.
  - One race each day will constitute a regatta. The Warning Signal for the first start of each day will be at 1130 hours.
- 5. The race on Saturday is open to all boats which have, or can obtain, an ARC rating, including ORC and one-design boats. The boat rating system will be ARC with 3 classes: Racing, Cruising Spinnaker and Cruising Non-Spinnaker. This changes BBYRA PART III, H 1.1. For Saturday, all boats not having an ARC rating will be assigned one, Cruising/Racing or Non-Spinnaker Rating J-24's, J-22's, Sonar, ORC boats and others will be put into the appropriate class based on their assigned ARC rating. The Race Committee reserves the right to divide the classes. Entry Fees payable on line are \$30 for Saturday's handicap-rated race.

Entries must be made on-line no later than 1900 Hours on Thursday, May 25th.

6. The race on Sunday is open only to one-design boats. **To Enter for Sunday, go to** <a href="https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25982# registration">https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25982# registration</a>. Entry Fees payable on line are \$25 for Sunday.

Entries must be made on-line no later than 1900 Hours on Friday, May 26th.

7. Protests shall be delivered within 1 hour after the Race Committee Signal Boat docks. The protest

time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the Regatta Network Notice Board and Hearing Schedule. Protest hearings will be conducted virtually (via Zoom) as soon as possible and in the approximate order in which they were filed. This changes BBYRA 15.2 Penalties and Protests.

- 8. Awards will be presented each day following the racing at approximately 1700 Hours on Saturday and as soon as is practical after the last race on Sunday
- 9. Venue
  - 9.1 The event venue shall be the Coconut Grove Sailing Club, Coconut Grove, FL.
  - 9.2 The safety of sailors and volunteers is paramount. All skippers, crews and interested parties must comply with all CGSC Health protocols. Please remember to socially distance at least six feet away from others, to wear a mask at all times while ashore, regularly wash your hands, and avoid touching your face. If you have any symptoms of Covid-19 or are feeling unwell, you shall stay away from the event premises and competitors.
  - 9.3 Parking inside the CGSC gate is for Members only. Parking is available on the circle outside the gate and at the Public Parking Garage next to the Arya Hotel.
