1 RULES

- 1.1 The Big Daddy Regatta is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 RRS 40.1 shall apply while crew are on the water.
- 1.3 The NCPHRF Part 1: Rules and Guidelines shall apply to boats racing in the PHRF divisions. These can be found at:

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Sailing instructions will be available after 1500 hrs. on Thursday, March 9, 2023 at the Richmond Yacht Club and on the Richmond Yacht Club website.
- 2.2 Changes to the *rules* will be posted on the official notice board by 0930 on the day they will take effect. Changes to the schedule of races will be posted by 1900 on the day before they will take effect.
- 2.3 PHRF and one design division assignments will be posted on the RYC website after 1500 hrs. March 10, 2023. One design fleets with more than 5 entries will be given a one-design start.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.2 The VHF channel used by the RC will be stated in the SIs.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The Saturday regatta is open to PHRF and One Design monohulled keelboats with a NCPHRF rating of 280 and below. Each competitor must have a current PHRF certificate. One design fleets with greater than 5 entries may be given a one-design start.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration found at:

- 4.3 No entries for Saturday and will be accepted after 1800 hrs. on Thursday March 9th.

5 FEES

- 5.1 The entry fee for Saturday is \$2.85 per foot.
- 5.2 No entries for Saturday and will be accepted after 1800 hrs. on Thursday March 9th.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1

Race	First Warning
Race 1	1125 hrs
Race 2	Immediately following Race #1
Race 3	Immediately following Race #2

7 COURSES

- 7.1 The racing area Saturday will be on three courses, Southampton, Olympic Circle, and Deep Water (southwest of the Olympic Circle). Racing will be around temporary marks.
- 7.2 Drop (inflatable) marks will be used. The deep water course may use some YRA buoys.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 PHRF time allowances shall be calculated using the Time on Time (TOT) method.
- 8.2 Three races are scheduled. All races will count toward the final score. This changes RRS A2.
- 8.3 PHRF scoring will be used for the purpose of awarding overall prizes.

9 PRIZES

- 9.1 Prizes will be awarded to first through third place finishers in each class with more than 6 boats, and to first and second place finishers for 5 boats.
- 9.2 The trophy presentation will be held on the RYC deck after the racing on Saturday March 11th.

10 INSURANCE

- 10.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
