1 RULES

- 1.1 The Big Daddy Pursuit Race is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 RRS 40.1 shall apply while crew are on the water.
- 1.3 The NCPHRF Part 1: Rules and Guidelines shall apply to boats racing in the PHRF divisions. These can be found at:

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Sailing instructions will be available after 1500 on Friday, March 10, 2023 at the Richmond Yacht Club and on the Richmond Yacht Club website.
- 2.2 Changes to the *rules* will be posted on the official notice board by 0930 on the day they will take effect. Changes to the schedule of races will be posted by 1900 on the day before they will take effect.
- 2.3 Starting times for the Sunday pursuit race will also be available after 1500 hrs. on March 11th.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The Sunday Big Daddy Pursuit Race is a PHRF Regatta, open to monohulled keelboats with a NCPHRF rating of 280 and below. The Pursuit Race is also open to multihulls with a valid BAMA rating.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration found at:

- 4.3 No entries for Sunday Pursuit Race will be accepted after 1300 on Friday March 10th.

5 FEES

- 5.1 The entry fee for the Sunday Pursuit Race is \$2.00 per foot.

6 SCHEDULE

7 COURSES

- 7.1 The Sunday race will start in the vicinity of Southampton Shoal and will finish near the Richmond Yacht Club. The Sunday Pursuit race course is around Angel and Alcatraz Islands, in either direction, with a reverse handicap start.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 PHRF time allowances shall be calculated using the Time on Time (TOT) method.
- 8.2 Sunday's race will be scored using regular PHRF for all divisions.

9 PRIZES

- 9.2 The trophy presentation will be held on the RYC deck after the racing on Sunday March 12th. Prizes will be awarded to monohulls who place first through tenth and multihulls will be awarded prizes for first through third finishes.

10 INSURANCE

- 10.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
