You must be at least 18 years old on the day of the regatta. <b>Also, your COWSHIP's entry form must be submitted and accepted in order for you to participate. This applies whether you name your COWSHIP or ABRA assigns you to a COWSHIP.</b>																					
1955	Pedro Newell		2	Only El Toro class boats may race. Your TORO need not be certified, but its sail must bear the shovel insignia and the sail number shown on your entry form.																					
1956	Russ Humphrey	(3)	3	LAUNCHING AND SAFETY CHECK-IN AT SYC: Toros may be launched from the Sausalito Yacht Club dock or elsewhere, but all skippers must appear at the Sausalito Yacht Club dock for a safety equipment check-in and skipper's signature.																					
1957	Danilo Herb		4	Check in with the Safety Committee between 7:30 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. (Arrive early and leave quickly to avoid a substantial parking fee.) Upon approval by the Safety Committee, you will receive an identifying ribbon to fly at the end of the boom until completion of the race. <b>TIE THE RIBBON SO THAT AT LEAST 18 INCHES WILL BE FLYING FREE.</b>
