Start: SATURDAY: Starting area will be approximately 1.2 nm SW of the Choptank Light (Area Mark "O"), towards G-13 (Area Mark "A"). At about N 38° 38.65' W 076° 12.35'. Second race will start as soon as possible after the first race.
 SUNDAY: Between an orange flag on the TAYC balcony and orange mark in Tred Avon River. Second non-sanctioned race will start as soon as possible after the first race.

Course: Either drop mark or Region 3 Choptank Area Standard Racing Marks, as designated by letters displayed on floating dock or Race Committee boat. Non-spinnaker may have a different course.

Finish: SATURDAY: Between an orange flag on Race Committee boat and dropped orange mark. If shortened, all classes finish between a mark of the original course and orange flag on Race Committee boat.
 SUNDAY: Between an orange flag on the Yacht Club balcony and Mark "N" (R "2"). If course is shortened, finish between last mark of shortened course and Race Committee boat.

Time Limit: 3 hours for each race.

Radio: Race Committee will attempt to notify premature starters on VHF 71.

Protests: Written protest must be delivered to Race Committee within 1 hour of the Race Committee boat reaching the dock Saturday or the last boat finishing the race Sunday. Protests heard as soon as possible after the last race of the day.

Awards: Awards will be given at the clubhouse after Sunday's racing.

Social: Light fare will be available after the finish of the second race each day. Bringing alcoholic beverages to and from the club premises is unlawful.
