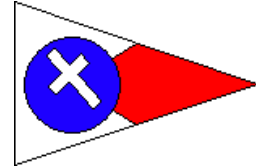

## Notice of Race

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.3 RRS 40.1 applies.
- 1.4 RRS A5.3 applies.
- 1.5 The Santa Cruz 27 (SC27) class will race under SC27 Class Constitution;

### 2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. See ISAF Regulation 20

### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 SC27 National Championship regattas are only open to boats deemed eligible by their respective class organizations that are fully paid and current members of the respective class organizations. <http://www.sc27.org/documents> SC27Constitution.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/26175>. Only online entries will be accepted.
- 3.3 Entries will be accepted up to 1800 hours on Wed May 24, 2023.

### 4 FEES

- 4.1 Entry Fee for the SC27 National Regatta is \$200 if completed by 2300 on May 12, 2023. A late fee of \$50 will be applicable to all entries received after 2300 hours on May 12, 2023. Registration closes on May 27, 2023 at 1000.
- 4.2 Saturday dinner is included in the entry fee.
- 4.3 All entry fees are non-refundable unless the regatta is cancelled. If the regatta is cancelled, entry fees will be refunded less any non-refundable RegattaNetwork charges.
- 4.4 SC27 National Class Association Dues are \$27.00 per calendar year. Dues are payable via PayPal [sc27nca@gmail.com](mailto:sc27nca@gmail.com)

### 5 VENUE

- 5.1 The starting area will be located within a 1.5 to 2 mile radius of Walton Lighthouse located on the west jetty of the Santa Cruz Harbor.
- 5.2 The race area is defined by a four (4) mile semi-circle centered at the Walton Lighthouse. This area extends to Natural Bridges State Park to the northwest and Soquel to the southeast.

### 6 COURSES

- 6.1 Inflatable marks will be used for windward-leeward courses. Inflatable and fixed marks can be used for the long distance race.

## SC27 Nationals NOR

6.2 Long Distance Race – Approx. 2 hrs. of sailing or 10 mile course.

### 7 SCORING

7.1 Seven races are scheduled. 4 completed races constitutes a regatta.

7.2 If fewer than 5 races are completed, a boat's overall score shall be the total of all completed races.

7.3 If 5 or more races are completed, a boat's overall score shall be the total of all completed races excluding her worst score.

### 9 BERTHING/ TRAILER STORAGE

9.1 Trailers are required to be parked in the trailer turn-around area adjacent to the bathrooms, or as directed by regatta volunteers.

9.2 Cars can park only in visitor parking spaces. Please do not risk a ticket so pay at parking pay stations before you leave your vehicle.

9.3 Boats will be assigned berthing within the Santa Cruz Harbor.

### 10 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

10.1 After the preparatory signal for the boat's first race, a boat shall not be hauled out except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

### 11 INSURANCE

11.1 Participating boats shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. Boat owners are solely responsible to ensure that such coverage is current and adequate.
