1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

American Legion Yacht Club (ALYC), 215 15th St. Newport Beach CA 92663 is the organizing authority for C's the Day. www.alyc.com

2. RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

3. Divisions

This event is open to Harbor 20 C Division sailors only. ("C" Division sailor is any sailor who has not qualified for Harbor 20 A or B Division, membership in Harbor 20 assoc. is not required).

4. Mentorship

Boats wishing to have a mentor on board must contact the Race Committee Chair, Scott Barnes race@alyc.com at least five days prior to the event to arrange a mentor.

5. ENTRIES AND FEES

5.1 Online entry is available at www.alyc.com through Regatta Network.

5.2 The entry fee for the race is \$25.00 and you may enter at anytime prior to 0900 hrs race day, but early registration is encouraged.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Sailing Instructions (SI's) will be available no later than 1700 April 28th and will be posted to the ALYC's website www.alyc.com through Regatta Network.

6.2 A race packet including the SI's and Newport Harbor map will be available at the Skippers meeting/Seminar on April 29th

7. SCHEDULE

7.1 1030 - 1100 Check in at ALYC 215 15th St, Newport Beach

1100 - 1200 Skipper meeting & Seminar - Into to Racing Rules of Sailing

1300 - Scheduled First Warning (start of race)

1500 - approx end of racing, meet back at ALYC for Award presentation, discussion, food and prizes

7.2 Two random leg races are scheduled.

7.3 Any changes to the schedule will be posted by 1900 the day before the race on the ALYC website through Regatta Network.

8. PRIZES

8.1 Prizes for first, second, and third place will be awarded for each race

8.2 Awards for first place overall will be awarded.

9. COURSES TO BE SAILED

9.1 Courses will be posted on a white board on the Race Committee boat.

9.2 The Start and Finish line will be in Newport Harbor in the "Five-Points" area.

9.3 Random leg courses in Newport Harbor will be sailed and shown in the SI's.

10. SCORING

10.1 Boats shall be scored based on their finish place, using RRS Appendix A.

10.2 There will be no throw-out, this modifies RRS Appendix A
