1 RULES

- 1.1 The Alerion 28 Regatta is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 RRS 40.1 shall apply while crew are on the water.
- 1.3 The Alerion Express 28 Class Rules shall apply.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Sailing instructions will be available after 1500 hrs. on Thursday, April 20, 2023 on the Richmond Yacht Club website.
- 2.2 Changes to the *rules* will be posted on the official notice board by 0930 on the day they will take effect. Changes to the schedule of races will be posted by 1900 on the day before they will take effect.

- 3.2 The VHF channel used by the RC will be stated in the SlS.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to Alerion 28 sailboats.

5 FEES

- 5.1 The entry fee is \$65.
- 5.2 No entries will be accepted after 1800 hrs. on Thursday April 20th.

6 SCHEDULE

Race 3	Immediately following Race #2

7 COURSES

- 7.1 The racing area will be between Southampton and south of Brooks Island.
- 7.2 Drop (inflatable) marks will be used.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 Three races are scheduled. All races will count toward the final score. This changes RRS A2.

9 PRIZES

- 9.1 Prizes will be awarded to first through third place finishers .
- 9.2 The trophy presentation will be held on the RYC deck after the racing on Sunday April 23rd.

10 INSURANCE

- 10.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
